 to the Northward loured did not get near
 him saw another going quick to the North
 Ends No Obsec by J.C.C.
 Lat 57° 20' Long 15° 20'

Wednesday May 30th
 Begins with light breezes from the Northward
 with rain heading W N W saw two
 rite whale going to the Northward at
 night took in sail A.M. fresh breezes from
 East N.E. saw one rite whale going quick
 to windward saw plenty of finbacks
 Ends No Obsec by J.C.C.
 Lat 58° 42' Long 146° 00'

Thursday May 31st
 Begins with strong breezes from E N E steering
 South with all sail set at 3 P.M. saw
 one rite whale loured got fast and took
 him long side at 9 P.M. loured
 on so heavy I expected nothing
 but what I should have him put a cutting
 fall on him and let him lay last part
 strong gales and clear weather
 Lat 58° 47' Long 145° 18'

Friday June 1st
 Begins with fresh gales from East at night
 weather more moderate got ready for cutting
 at one A.M. commenced cutting blow on heavy
 from N.E. with heavy rain got the whale cut in
 last part heavy gales with foggy and rain
 Ends No Obsec

Saturday June 2nd
 Begins with heavy gales from N.E. with rain and
 fog heading S.E. by E last part moderate gales with a heavy
 swell on started the work saw finbacks
 Lat 59° 41' Long 147° 04'

Sunday June 3rd
 Begins with light breezes from East and clear
 weather heading to the Southward saw finbacks
 last part calm and pleasant
 Lat 58° 28' Long 147° 58'

Monday June 4th
 Begins with light breeze from the Eastward saw
 plenty of finbacks last part fresh breezes from
 N.E. saw plenty of finbacks finished hocking
 Lat 57° 23' Long 147° 43'

Tuesday June 5th
 Begins with fresh breezes from the N.E. steering
 South at 4 P.M. saw two rite whale loured
 did not get fast they was going quick at 8
 saw two more loured with no better success
 whale very shy A.M. spoke ship Scotland
 New Bedford two whale this season saw
 her get fast to another loured far
 whale but did not get fast
 Lat 56° 55' Long 149° 05'
