Wednesday June 6th
Begins with strong breezes from the Northward saw two rite whale going quick to the Northward saw another went on to him "At last must him went on to him again and met last part fresh breezes with fog and rain"

Thursday June 7th
Begins with fresh breezes and foggy weather slowed down the sail in the fore haled last part light breezes from S.W. with some fog saw finbacks Thus Ends 15th June

Friday June 8th
Begins with light breezes from S.W. heading S.E. saw a whales carcass and number of finbacks last part light breeze from the Southward saw plenty of finbacks Lat 58.28 Long 149.24

Saturday June 9th
Begins with light breeze from the Southward steering to the westward saw finbacks the land knows when I shall get a whale
At 10 saw one rite whale burred got fast and cirked the line off Land look and more of it Lat 56.36 Long 150.00

Sunday June 10th
Begins with calm weather saw finbacks last part light breezes from S.W. saw finbacks Lat 56.40 Long 151.27

Heard Frank comes up in the rigging for line to cut and pull down the line into the water tank

Monday June 11th
Begins with light breezes from S.W. heading N.W. saw finbacks saw a ship steering to the Northward at 10 P.M. spoke ship Schottland steered to the westward in company At 10 saw her pick up a dead whale last part light breezes from the Southward saw plenty of humpbacks Lat 58.00 Long 150.40

Tuesday June 12th
Begins with light breezes from the Southward saw humpbacks saw the land last part pleasant breezes from S.W. steering East saw finbacks and humpbacks plenty of birds Lat 58.30 Long 148.58

Wednesday June 13th
Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. steering East saw nothing and seems as thou I never should get another whale last part wind from South and very light saw finbacks Lat 57.41 Long 145.59

Thursday June 14th
Begins with light breeze from S.E. steering N.E. per compass saw finbacks At 10 saw 4 ships three sailing saw three rite whale burred did not get fast saw mount Eies Lat 58.24 Long 145.50

Friday June 15th
Begins with light breezes from the Eastward at 6 p.m. saw three rite whale burred got fast took the line heard look and seems as if I never should have any more boats all that I can see At 10 saw whale burred did not get fast saw another went on to one Yama Ceter met him a first waste chance seem is sick and some he good for nothing so it goes Ends
