Saturday July 14th
Begins with fresh gales from S.W.
Heading N.W. with close reef to sails
set on dulle and last part winds light
and baffling Lat 52° 46" Long 165° 40

Sunday July 15th
Begins with light breezes from the
Southward heading N.W. by S and foggy
last part fresh breezes and clear by spells
saw plenty of finbacks going quick in
shore Lat 52° 44" Long 166° 10

Monday July 16th
Begins with fresh breezes from the southward
and fog squalls plenty of finbacks
at night saw one Alaska dist 30 miles
at night wind hauled to the westward
tacked ship heading to the southward A.M.
stayed in shore Lat 52° 50" Long 168° 01

Tuesday July 17th
Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. heading
N.W. per compass at 6 P.M. saw
Cummashka bearing N.W. dist 10 miles
tacked ship heading S.S.E. saw the South
Island bearing N.W. A.M. saw a cow and
calf bound got fast to the calf killed the calf
got fast to the cow two boats she kicked
the iron out away she went she acted
heiried had better back next time

Wednesday July 18th
Begins with light bree from S.W. cut the
whale in Cummashka Island in sight distance
20 miles last part calm weath with sun
foggy Lat 52° 15" Long 169° 58

Thursday July 19
Begins with calm weather at night the the sailing
of four mountains took them to be last part calm
and foggy Thus Ends Lat 52° 10" Long 170° 07

Friday July 20
Begins with calm weather and fog at 1 P.M.
cleared up with light bree from West heading
N.W. saw Youngasha Island bearing N by E dist
20 miles at 8 P.M. land 5 miles distance tacked
ship heading S.W. set in thick with fine rain
threw the night calm at 5 A.M. cleared up sun
saw Youngasha Island about three miles off got set
down to in by the current took the boats and
towed her off last part light bree from south
with thick fog passed threw very strong tide
waves Thus Ends

Saturday July 21
Begins with light bree from the southward
heading E.S.E. at 5 P.M. wind hauled S.E. tacked
ship heading S.S.W. by compass at night blow
on fresh with heavy rains at twelve blow
heavy took in the foresail abole reef the main
topmast last part light breezes with a heavy swell
on with thick fog No Sailed by Fee 52° 05"
Longitude 171° 33
