attended with rain Ends No Observation

heading N^W by N per compass with foresail and

moderate set Double reef topsail Ends

heading N^W by N with Double reef topsails
set last part light breezes and pleasant
weather the first good weather for about a
month Lat 52.45 Long 165.08

Thursday Aug 9th
Begins with light breezes from the North
ward and fine weather heading to the
westward middle and last part calm

Friday Aug 10th
Begins with light breezes from S & steering N by E
stowed down the oil in the after hatch last part
light breezes from S & by N with thick fog
