

Ship Clematis New London

Saturday Aug 11

Begins with light breezes from SSW with thick fog steering North at 8 P.M. water discovered hauled on the wind heeling West middle and last part strong breezes and foggy Ends No Observation
By Sec Lat 55° 20' Long 164° 00'

Sunday August 12

Begins with strong breezes and foggy weather but a few mastsails last part fresh breezes and cloudy saw Sperm whale and plenty of finbacks Ends the day
Lat 55° 15' Long 165° 16'

Monday August 13

Begins with light breezes from South saw finbacks but two boats in fishing caught a W. lot of codfish last part strong breezes from N.E. saw nothing but humpbacks
Lat 55° 24' Long 165° 20'

Tuesday August 14

Begins with fresh gales from N.E. saw humpbacks last part strong breezes and cloudy weather saw plenty of finbacks Ends No Obs
By Sec Lat 56° 00' Long 165° 30'

Wednesday August 15th

Begins with light gales from N.E. steering West at 4 P.M. saw ship Kametshaka 10 miles distance saw plenty of finbacks middle and last part strong gales with fog Ends No Observation

Thursday Aug 16th

Begins with fresh gales from N.E. with thick fog last part weather about the same kept off steering South saw nothing and no likelihood of seeing any thing again No Observation
By Sec Lat 55° 20' Long 162° 00'

Friday Aug 17th

Begins with fresh gales from N.E. with sun fog and rain last part strong gales as usual saw plenty of finbacks Lat 55° 20' Long 160° 30'

Saturday Aug 18th

Begins with fresh gales from N.E. and cloudy weather saw plenty of finbacks last part strong breezes with heavy rains saw nothing and never expect to see any thing here Ends No Obs
By Sec Lat 54° 40' Long 159° 00'

Sunday August 19th

Begins with strong breezes from N.E. with rain and fog as far good weather it is out of the question last part light breezes with heavy rains Ends
Lat 54° 25' Long 160° 25'

Monday August 20

Begins with light breezes from the Northward and thick weather last part fresh gales with cloudy weather saw finbacks Ends
Latitude 50° 30' Long 158° 30'

Tuesday August 21

Begins with fresh gales from the Northward steering W by S at night cleared off sun set clear for the first time for 8 months last part light breeze and calm a heavy swell heaving from N.E. saw the land dist 25 miles Latitude 50° 05' Long 157° 00'
