Begins with light breeze and calm weather last part pleasant breezes spoke ship
uncas New Bedford bound to New Zealand
Lat 16° 10' Long 156° 50'

Thursday Oct 11

Begins with fine breezes and pleasant weather steering S E middle and last part strong breezes with heavy squall and rain attended with thunder and lightning
