

Ship Clematis New London

Wednesday Nov 7th

Begins with light breeze from S^W heading S^E by S repaired the foresail and bent it last part strong breeze and clear weather employed making a messenger topsail smaller
Lat 25° 34' Long 164° 30'

Thursday Nov 8th

Came with strong breezes from S^W heading S^E by S with one reef in the topsails last part weather about the same
Lat 26° 47' Long

Friday Nov 9

Begins with strong breezes from S^W heading S^E by S last part light breezes from S^E heading S^W
Lat 30° 24' Long

Saturday Nov 10

Begins with light breezes from S^E heading S^W by S last part fresh breezes from East steering South Lat 34° 51' Long

Sunday Nov 11

Begins with fresh breezes from the Eastward steering South last part strong breezes from the Northward saw thousands of finbacks
Lat 34° 16' Long 164° 34'

Monday Nov 12

Begins with strong breezes from the Northward steering S by E at 4 P.M. hauled up S & at 6 P.M. saw any quantity of finbacks and number of white whale hauled Stowell Most one I went on to one hauled never sailed last part saw nothing but finbacks crossed over which I saw them last night
Lat 35° 05' Long 164° 15'

Cruising for Whale on New Zealand

Tuesday Nov 13

Begins with light breezes from S^E and fine weather at night saw plenty of finbacks and whale had shortened sail at 16 kips off S^E saw nothing about the main topsail repaired it Ends
Lat 35° 27' Long 163° 26'

Wednesday Nov 14

Came with fresh breezes from S^E steering S^E bent the main topsail again last part strong breezes from the Northward
Lat 37° 46' Long 161° 35'

Thursday Nov 15

Begins with strong breezes from the Northward steering S^E by E at 6 P.M. spoke ship Mount Wallessee New Bedford hauling and a whale long side ship Columbus in sight Lat about 35° 10' Long 161° 20' middle and last part strong gales with heavy rains Ends

Friday Nov 16

Commences with strong gales with heavy rains at 4 P.M. saw a white whale toward did not get fast at night saw another get fast after dark and dark hair had beginning makes a good ending last part fine weather saw nothing Lat 38° 28' Long 161° 19'

Saturday Nov 17

Begins with light breezes from the westward heading to the Southward at 4 P.M. saw one white whale toward did sea hair again Ship Mount Wallessee in sight at 16 saw one white whale going quick to the Southward toward went out of sight Ends
Lat 39° 14' Long 161° 00'
