Sunday Nov 18

Begins with light breezes from S W
heading S S E saw one right whale loured
saw none of him A M saw one loured
got fast my boat drove me very bad
broke the keel in two places stove in six
streaks
Lat 39° 35' Long 160° 40'

Monday Nov 19

Begins with light breeze and pleasant
weather took the whale long hulk
and cast him in started the warby
last part saw plenty of porpoises Ench
Lat 39° 50' Long 161° 10'

Tuesday Nov 20

Begins with light breeze from the Northward
heading West picked up a small finback
last part strong breezes heading off by S
saw one finback Lat 39° 45' Long 162° 26'

Wednesday Nov 21

Begins with fresh breezes from S W W
heading W by N with double reef tops
set finished hauling A M broke out the after
hatch stowed down the oil Ench the Day

Thursday Nov 22

Begins with strong breezes from the Northward
checked the after hatch off with oil last
part strong gales from N E Ench N. O. O.

Friday Nov 23

Begins with fresh gales from N E stowed
the provisions in the after hatch between decks
last part moderat breezes and fine weather
saw nothing Lat 40° 24' Long 163° 15'

Cruising for Whales on New Zealand

Saturday Nov 24

Begins with light breezes from the Northward and
fine weather steering E S E saw nothing A M saw
one white whale loured did not get fast saw him again
loured with no better success Lat 41° 20' Long 162° 00'

Sunday Nov 25

Came with strong breezes from the Northward with some
rain at night took in sail heading to the Eastward
A M saw one white whale loured saw none of him
Lat 41° 30' Long 161° 15'

Monday Nov 26

Came with light breeze from the northward with rain
at 2 P M cleared wind hauled to the westward
saw nothing at night fresh gale at 8 A M saw one
white whale loured did not get fast Lat 41° 15' Long 161° 00'

Tuesday Nov 27

Begins with calm and rain squalls with a
heavy swell on saw one white whale loured took
him long side cut him in cleared up
Jacks till started the warby last part calm
Ench Lat 41° 22' Long 160° 30'

Wednesday Nov 28

Begins with calm weather imployed hauling
last part strong breezes from the Southward
saw nothing Lat 41° 00' Long 160° 20'

Thursday Nov 29

Begins with strong breezes from south
heading to the Westward at night fresh gale
finished hauling last part weather more moderat
set double reef topsails Lat 40° 30'
