Saturday April 19<sup>th</sup>  
 Com with heavy gales from S<sup>W</sup>  
 steering S & by E with close reef topsails  
 set last part fresh breezes from E<sup>N</sup> & heading  
 S & E Ends Lat 38° 22' Long 169° 10'

Sunday April 20<sup>th</sup>  
 Com with strong breezes from E<sup>N</sup> & heading  
 S & at night squally last part strong breezes  
 as usual Lat 39° 44' Long 167° 50'

Sunday April 20<sup>th</sup> altered the  
 day on account of being East of the Antipodes  
 Begins with fresh breezes from N<sup>W</sup> & heading  
 E<sup>N</sup> & ship commenced making at night  
 found 16 fathoms in her 100 fathoms from  
 N<sup>W</sup> employed looking for bells stopped down  
 round the bow last part light breeze from  
 N<sup>W</sup> & pleasant Lat 40° 48' Long 165° 30'

Monday April 21<sup>st</sup>  
 Begins with pleasant breezes from N<sup>W</sup>  
 steering East with all sail set last part  
 wind shifted set gallant bluebellied sails Ends  
 Lat 41° 24' Long 162° 46'

Tuesday April 22<sup>nd</sup>  
 Begins with pleasant breezes from West steering  
 East with all sail set last part weather the  
 same Lat 41° 30' Long 159° 15'

Wednesday April 23<sup>rd</sup>  
 Com with fresh gales from N<sup>W</sup> steering East  
 with all sail set last part wind shifted Ends  
 Lat 42° 31' Long 155° 29'

## Bound Towards Cape Horn

Thursday April 24<sup>th</sup>  
 Begins with fresh gales from West steering E by S  
 with all sail set last part weather the same  
 Lat 42° 42' Long 151° 50'

Friday April 25<sup>th</sup>  
 Com with fresh gales from N<sup>W</sup> & steering E by N  
 per compass with all sail set last part light breezes  
 and thick weather Ends No Observ by Acc  
 Lat 43° 00' Long 149° 00'

Saturday April 26<sup>th</sup>  
 Begins with light baffling winds from West steering  
 East with all sail set last part fresh breezes  
 and thick rainy weather Ends No Observation  
 By Acc Lat 43° 15' Long 146° 00'

Sunday April 27<sup>th</sup>  
 Com with fresh breezes from West and thick rainy  
 weather steering E by N with all sail set  
 last part strong breezes from East Lat 42° 54' Long by Acc 144° 00'

Monday April 28<sup>th</sup>  
 Begins with fresh breezes from East heading S & E  
 at night heading S & by E last part fresh gales  
 from N<sup>W</sup> steering East Lat 43° 00' Long 140° 55'

Tuesday April 29<sup>th</sup>  
 Com with fresh gales from N<sup>W</sup> steering East  
 with gallant sails set at night blows on heavy  
 double reef the topsails at twelve hours to blowing  
 very heavy from N<sup>W</sup> with plenty of rain  
 At 10 weather more moderate wind N<sup>W</sup> & double  
 reef topsails at twelve wind hauled South blowing  
 tremendous heavy took in main top sail down to  
 under a main spencer Ends No Observ by Acc  
 Charles Stokely  
 Lat 43° 31' Long 138° 40'
