about sun set the main topsail close reef
last part blow on very heavy in squalls

Begins with very heavy gales from South
at night blows on tremendous heavy in squalls
took in the main topsail middle and last
part weather about the same Ends No Obs

Friday May 2nd

Begins with heavy gales from South with
heavy squalls and high sea at 4 P.M. set
close reef topsails hup off N.E. last strong
gales as usual Lat 41-15 Long 156-00

Saturday May 3rd

Begins with heavy gales from South
steering N.E. by East with close reef
topsails set last part light gales from S.E. and
squally Ends Lat 40-46 Long 152-20

Sunday May 4th

Come with strong breezes from S.E. and squally
steering East with gallantails set last part
light breezes and baffling with a heavy swell on
Ends Lat 41-12 Long 129-50

Bound towards Cape Horn

Monday May 5th

Begins with calm weather last part light breezes
from the Northward and squally Ends

Lat 42-25 Long 129-50

Tuesday May 6th

Come with light breeze from the Northward and squally
steering E by S last part weather the same Ends

Lat 42-32 Long 124-50

Wednesday May 7th

Begins with strong breezes from N.W. and squally
steering E by S with all sail set at night blows
on fresh took in gallantails last part fresh gales
Double reef the topsails Ends Lat 48-42 Long 121-50

Thursday May 8th

Come with fresh gales from N.W. steering
E by S with Double reef topsails set at night
blows on heavy close reef the topsails wind hauld
more to the Northward steering S.E. at 9 A.M. wind
hauld that in a tremendous squall with rain
took in sail down to at 5th hup off on lower
course last part light gales and clear weather

Friday May 9th

Begins with fresh breezes from S.W.
steering E by S with gallantails set middle
calm last part light breezes from W.N.W.

Lat 45-35 Long 118-00

Saturday May 10th

Begins with light breezes from W.N.W. and
baffling steering E by S last part fresh
breezes Lat 46-50 Long 114-44
