

Ship Clements New London

Friday June 6th

Begins with light wind from South and
suddenly steering S by E with blustering winds
Set last part light and pleasant weather
Ends lat 45° 30' long 47° 20'

Saturday June 7th

Begins with light breeze from S by E steering
S by E with all sail set last part wind W by N
and pleasant lat 41° 52' long 46° 30'

Sunday June 8th

Begins with light breeze from W by N steering
S by E at night wind N by W heading
N by E last part fresh gales and squally squalls
with the topsails Ends lat 40° 28' long 45° 50'

Monday June 9th

Begins with fresh gales from N by W heading
N by E with double reef topsails set then the
knights heavy rain last part calm Ends
lat 40° 04' long 45° 00'

Tuesday June 10th

Begins with calm weather at night light
breeze from East middle blows heavy from N by E
were ship took in sail heading S by E at 6 AM
took in the main topsail last part blow a hurricane
sum of the squalls most dreadful sent down
the mizen gallant yard Ends N's Observation
by Ace lat 40° 00' long 45° 20'

Bound for New London

Wednesday June 11th

Begins with very heavy gales from N by E heading
S by E at 5 AM wind haul W by N blows on very
heavy in squally middle wind about the same
with a high sea on ship a good deal of water
last part fresh gales from S by W steering N by E
per compass lat 39° 26' long 45° 00'

Thursday June 12th

Begins with fresh gales from S by W steering N by E
with double reef topsails set S by W more moderate
set fore and main gallant sails last part blow on
fresh wind haul N by W Ends lat 37° 56' long 42° 00'

Friday June 13th

Begins with fresh gales from N by W steering N by E
took in gallant sails double reef the topsails
last part pleasant breeze from S by W set shuddering sails
sent up main royal yard and mizen gallant yard
lat 35° 24' long 39° 16'

Saturday June 14th

Begins with pleasant breeze from S by W steering N by E
with all sail set last part calm saw a ship on
the harbour quarter lat 34° 14' long 38° 30'

Sunday June 15th

Begins with light breeze and calm weather steering
N by E two sails in sight sent out the flying jib
boom last part light breeze from E by S heading N by E
lat 33° 22' long 38° 00'

Monday June 16th

Came with light breeze from N by E last part fresh breeze
from E by S heading South lat 31° 51' long 38° 40'
