Monday July 7th

Begins with calm weather at 8 P.M.
Had a heavy squall from N.E. took
in gallant sails double reefed the topsails
in reefing the foretopmast John Carley
and Michael Glenn got in to a quarrel
when they got down in deck Michael
slaked John Carley in four different
places two cuts in the head one in
the breast the other in the arm
Dress his wounds and took Michael
and put him in to irons last part light
and from East Lat 7° 15 Long 40° 00

Tuesday July 8

Begins with light breezes from East
steering N.W. by N last part calm took
Michael Glenn out of irons he promised to
behave him self Lat 7° 55 Long 41° 20

Wednesday July 9

Begins with calm weather and rain squall
as far track winds is more expect to get them
middle and last part weather the same
Ends 30 Observation

Thursday July 10

Begins with calm weather and ends
the same saw a school of blackfish
lanced got fast to one and drew
Lat 8° 25 Long 40° 50

Friday July 11th

Begins with calm weather and rain squalls
lanced and got three blackfish at night strong
breezes from N.E. steering N.W.
Lat 9° 24 Long 41° 56

Bound for New London

Saturday July 12th

Begins with strong trades from N.E. passed
threw a great many tide ruffles last part light
breezes and pleasant Lat 10° 56 Long 43° 35

Sunday July 13th

Begins with light breezes from N.E. and pleasant
steering N.W. by W ends the same
Lat 11° 57 Long 45° 45

Monday July 14th

Begins with light breezes from N.E. and pleasant steering
N.W. ends the same Lat 13° 15 Long 47° 50

Tuesday July 15th

Begins with light breezes from N.E. steering N.W. employed
washing bone last part strong breezes ends
Lat 14° 50 Long 49° 16

Wednesday July 16th

fresh trades and pleasant breeze N.W.
finished hunting bone last part employed
painting spars Lat 16° 45 Long 51° 00

Thursday July 17

Begins with fresh trades from E by S steering
N.W. at night squally last part pleasant
employed painting the lower masts
Lat 18° 20 Long 53° 51

Friday July 18

All these 24 hours fresh breezes and squally
weather steering N.W. Lat 20° 01 Long 55° 05

well returned
to duty

Saturday July 19

first and last part light breezes and
pleasant threw the night squally
Lat 21° 59 Long 56° 50
