Begins with light breeze from West at night heavy thunder showers and sharper lightning Double reef the topsails at twelve clear off made all sail last part light breeze and pleasant

Came with pleasant breeze from West heading N. E. by N. at night came on bad weather sent down royal yards Double reef the topsails last part fresh gales and squally
