

## Ship Clements New London

Saturday August 2  
Begins with strong breezes from the  
Northward heading  $22^{\circ}$  by  $N^{\circ}$  last part  
wind the same saw two ships bound East  
Lat  $34^{\circ}16'$  Long  $68^{\circ}46'$

Sunday August 3  
Com with strong breezes from  $N^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$   
heading  $3^{\circ}$  & headwinds and likely to remain  
so last part wind and weather about  
the same Lat  $34^{\circ}33'$  Long  $68^{\circ}16'$

Monday August 4  
Begins with fresh breezes from  $N^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$   
heading  $3^{\circ}$  & last part light breezes  
Lat  $35^{\circ}08'$  Long  $68^{\circ}40'$   
By Lunar Obs  $68^{\circ}42'$

Tuesday August 5  
Begins with head winds as usual and likely  
to remain so last part light breezes from  
West Lat  $35^{\circ}48'$  Long  $68^{\circ}40'$

Wednesday Aug 6  
Begins with light breezes from  $W^{\circ}$  by  $S^{\circ}$   
steering  $N^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$  by  $S^{\circ}$  middle a heavy thunder  
squall last part very heavy squalls with  
plenty of rain wind hauls  $N^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$   
Lat  $37^{\circ}25'$  Long  $69^{\circ}05'$

Thursday Aug 7  
Begins with head winds as usual  
last part calm Lat  $37^{\circ}56'$  Long  $68^{\circ}50'$   
the gulf stream detouring me to the  $S^{\circ}$  &  $E^{\circ}$   
about me and a half miles an hour

## Bound to New London

Friday August 8th  
Begins with calm weather a heavy swell  
heaving from  $S^{\circ}$  &  $E^{\circ}$  and strong current spoke  
schooner Sullivan two days from New York left  
past five breezes from  $E^{\circ}$  &  $S^{\circ}$  about three knots  
current setting to the Eastward these 24 hours  
Lat  $38^{\circ}12'$  Long  $67^{\circ}41'$

Saturday August 9th  
Begins with light breezes from  $E^{\circ}$  &  $S^{\circ}$  steering  
 $N^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$  last part light breezes from  $S^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$   
Lat  $38^{\circ}44'$  Long  $69^{\circ}00'$

Sunday August 10th  
Com with light breezes from  $S^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$  heading  $21^{\circ}$  by  $S^{\circ}$   
threw the light winds light and baffling  
heavy thunder showers in the gulf stream  
last part light breezes from West  
Lat  $39^{\circ}21'$  Long  $70^{\circ}00'$

Monday August 11th  
Begins with light breezes from West heading  
 $N^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$  at 4 P.M. took ship heading  $S^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$   
at 6 P.M. light winds from  $S^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$  steering  $W^{\circ}$  by  $N^{\circ}$   
saw a great many ships bound to the  
Eastward Lat  $39^{\circ}56'$  Long  $71^{\circ}15'$

Tuesday August 12th  
Begins with strong breezes from  $S^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$   
steering  $W^{\circ}$  by  $N^{\circ}$  saw number of ships  
bound East at 6 P.M. saw the land 40 fathoms  
mud and sand took in gallantails kip off  
 $N^{\circ}$  by  $W^{\circ}$
