Hour Day out Wind Course Remarks on board Thursday Jan 10th
 14.7 S.E. 11.00 First part light and pleasant
 " " in starting sails and shifted to the
 " " S.W. wind.
 " " Latt by Cleve at 11.00
 " " spoke the ship Enterprise of
 " " contact with our ship.
 " " Middle part on a port tack
 " " in company with the Enterprise.
 " " Latter part at 9.30 kept off at 11.00
 " " at 11.00 saw the Island of ~~Atterbury~~
 " " bearing N.E. 11.
 " " Latt by marion alt 1.02 S.

Hour Day out Wind Course Remarks on board Friday Jan 11th
 15.0 S.E. First part freshening as we drew in
 " " towards the land, running along within
 " " 5 miles of the East shore, at 4 P.M.
 " " Luffed too off Lee Bay, in company with
 " " the Enterprise, heading off S.W.
 " " Middle part moderate towards morning
 " " Latter part standing in Lee Bay
 " " Weather Bay, at 10.30 took a moderate
 " " breeze starting along the West side
 " " of Atterbury. Enterprise in company
 " " saw two sail to leeward standing
 " " off shore, peak the Henry Taber
 " " Latt by marion alt 1.30 S.
