1 P.M.	225, E, E	First part moderate trades and pleasant weather, with passing clouds.
"	"	Left by Kanihiki Alt 22.46 W.
"	"	Middle part moderate and pleasant.
"	"	Left part the same, the squalls less frequent and more light.

1 P.M.	225, E, E	First part fresh trades and rain squalls, variously employed.
"	"	Left by Kanihiki Alt 165.38 W.
