 130 P.M. 54.27 S. W. E. P. E.  
 First part light breeze and foggy clouds passing low, saw a mother ship to leeward.  
 Saw one whale, toward without success, blue water, 13.00  
 Lengt by Obs. Alt 15.00 11'  
 Middle part of weather the same, began to under what the  
 Latter part at daylight sail saw a whale toward three boats, and struck, and took along side and commenced cutting.  
 Black Eagle in sight, comin' from

Hours Day out Wind Course Remarks on board Monday May 26<sup>th</sup>  
 130 P.M. 54.27 S. W. E. P. E.  
 First part moderate and pleasant weather employed in bailing, the water slightly discolored.  
 Lengt by Obs. Alt 14.9. 58 11'  
 Saw fore whale, toward without success, shortened sail at 10 o'clock.  
 Middle part the same on opposite side.  
 Latter part moderate same, by the 11 o'clock saw two whales to leeward without success, blue water.  
 Latt by marilion Alt. 53.37 cl.

Hours Day out Wind Course Remarks on board Tuesday May 27<sup>th</sup>  
 130 P.M. 54.27 S. W. E. P. E.  
 First part light breeze and thick foggy employed in cutting at 10 o'clock, first cutting.  
 Middle part the same with mirraling rain at daylight started the work.  
 Latter part moderate breeze and foggy employed in bailing.  
 Latt by marilion Alt. 53.50 cl.

Hours Day out Wind Course Remarks on board Wednesday May 28<sup>th</sup>  
 130 P.M. 54.27 S. W. E. P. E.  
 First part moderate breeze and pleasant weather, somewhat smoky employed in bailing, saw a few finbacks, blue water.  
 Lengt by Obs. Alt 14.5 11'  
 Middle part the same about daylight cooler down finback bailing.  
 Latter part light and pleasant weather saw one whale, blue water.  
 at 10 o'clock foggy employed in stowing off between decks.  
 Latt by marilion Alt. 54.17 cl. four barrels

Hours Day out Wind Course Remarks on board Thursday May 29<sup>th</sup>  
 130 P.M. 54.27 S. W. E. P. E.  
 First part fresh breeze and foggy squalls near by, spills, the water much discolored.  
 Lengt by Obs. Alt 15.05 11'  
 Middle part the same under short sail by the 11 o'clock.  
 Latter part fresh and pleasant, employed in bailing.  
 at 11 A.M. spoke the Enterprise cutting her second whale.  
 saw fore whale, toward without success, at dark shortened sail.  
 Latt by marilion Alt 54.18 cl.

Hours Day out Wind Course Remarks on board Friday May 30<sup>th</sup>  
 130 P.M. 54.27 S. W. E. P. E.  
 First part light breeze and foggy, with an occasional light streak.  
 Lengt by Obs. Alt 14.75 11'  
 Middle part the same under short sail.  
 Latter part moderate breeze and foggy clouds overhead, saw whales, toward the boats without success, employed in stowing down, blue water.
