

Haver 24p out 11m 5. Coines  
 134, 357 E.  
 11.2.10  
 Remarks on board Monday Aug 11th  
 First part fresh breeze and  
 foggy, squalls with rain and veering  
 to the S, started about 45 lbs of  
 oil in the starboard tank.  
 Middle part cleared and  
 squalls, and thick fog.  
 Latter part strong breeze  
 and a sharp gale, rain coming  
 still foggy, but clearing.  
 This morning commenced stowing down

 Remarks on board Tuesday Aug 12th  
 First part moderate breeze  
 still foggy, employed in coining  
 and stowing down the oil still  
 in the tank.  
 Middle part moderate breeze  
 Latter part light breeze, much  
 clear, then moderate with light  
 breeze, employed in coining  
 and stowing down, 100 lbs of oil and  
 one other cask.

 136, 359, 11.2.10  
 Remarks on board Wednesday Aug 13th  
 First part light breeze  
 and clearing, with occasional fog  
 squalls, employed in coining.  
 Middle part moderate breeze  
 Latter part moderate breeze, some  
 clearing, passing high, saw the  
 Stribon take a good share, the  
 Endeavour in sight, saw two  
 other sails, still employed  
 in coining, at 10 AM, out  
 in foggy.

 136, 360 E.  
 11.2.10  
 Remarks on board Thursday Aug 14th  
 First part fresh breeze and thick  
 fog, and smooth water, very much  
 circular, spoke the Baltic for whales.  
 Middle part thick fog, and hard  
 rain, towards morning finished coining.  
 Latter part light thick fog, and  
 veering on two sails in sight,  
 water very much increased.  
 Left by morning at 5 AM, 11.2.10  
 Long by Cape Alb. 103.29 11.2.10

Haver 24p out 11m 5. Coines  
 137, 361, 11.2.10  
 Remarks on board Friday Aug 15th  
 First part breeze on the light gale  
 the clouds breaking, saw, occasionally quite  
 clear, employed in coining out.  
 Middle part moderate breeze, still foggy.  
 Latter part fresh breeze and quite  
 squalls, employed in stowing down.

Haver 24p out 11m 5. Coines  
 138, 362, 11.2.10  
 Remarks on board Saturday Aug 16th  
 First part fresh breeze and thick  
 weather, the fog lifting by spells,  
 saw several whales, saw one  
 or two, then sail in sight.  
 Middle part moderate breeze, some clearing  
 the same.  
 Latter part increasing to strong breeze  
 the fog lifting occasionally, saw three or  
 four whales, several sails in sight,  
 finished stowing down, 372 lbs.
