Remarks On Board Monday March 2

Came With light winds and calm and
pleasant weather & heading at 6 AM
the winds from the S & the middle
and latter part moderate heading from
the E and passing clouds heading to the E
implein in Coopering did not sail down
nothing in sight

Lat 4-05 S Long 140-25 W
So ends these twenty four hours

Remarks On Board Tuesday March 3

Came With moderate winds from E
and passing clouds & heading at 11 AM
in sight the middle & latter part moderate
winds from the E & squalls & heading
at 11 AM for calm implein in heading
out the after hole & stowed the hole of
sperm oil & took out 37 lbs of meat
& headed it & stowed it back & opened
& lashed up bottom & nothing in sight

Lat 2-25 S Long 140-25 W
So ends these twenty four hours

Remarks On Board Monday March 16

Came With light and baffling winds
here & pleasant heading toward Kaula
bay & 3 PM dropped anchor in 25 fathoms
of water & lashed the sails & cap-
went on shore & at 5 PM sent about in
skiff & at 7 PM the cap came on board
all this day light breezes from S & Head
Employed in painting ship outside this day
has 36 hours

Lat - Long -
So ends this day

Remarks On Board Tuesday March 17

Came With moderate breeze and
cloudy and Employed in painting & sent
on shore to bury down & at 1 PM raised
sails and for out to Kaula bay more clouds
this day has 12 hours
So ends this day

Remarks On Board Wednesday March 18

Came With strong breeze and clouds and
Employed in painting ship out side at 7 PM
light air and at anchor & clear weather
So ends this day

Remarks On Board Thursday March 19

Came With moderate winds and passing
clouds & Employed in painting ship
and broke out 3 larks of feed from the
fore hold at 7 PM saw thunder and
lightning with calm
So ends this day

Remarks On Board Friday March 20

Came With moderate wind and rain
and reversely implein about the ship at
at 5 PM heavy rain with thunder and
lightning and 3 heavy back to back and
now lower these boats without a loss at
anchor
So ends this day
