and at 10 AM under the yard & haul in
light sails & under reefed topsails &
variously bunched nothing in sight

Calm With strong wind from the
N.W. with thin & rainy weather
astoring at par compass & steering by
and nothing in sight the middle & later
part strong breeze from the N.W. &
and steering at par compass & 6 AM the
wind increased to a moderate gale & haul in
the fore topsail & set nothing in sight
and open a board of bread

Remarks On Board Wednesday Apr 16

Calm With moderate gale and passing
clouds and at 3 PM more moderate & set the
fore topsail & reefed Enchiridion in
haul in over potatoes & steering at par
compass the middle & later part moderate
gale from the N.W. & at 7 PM more moderate
and set the fore & main topsails & turned the reef
out of the topsail & steering at par compass
Employed in starting water nothing in sight

Calm With strong breeze & passing
clouds & fine weather the wind from the N.W.
and steering at par compass & at 3 PM
under the fore & main topsails & steering

moderate gale from the N.W. & steering at par
compass under double reefed topsails & nothing
in sight & steering by Enchiridion
