Thursday Dec 17th
Commenced with a light breeze from the

weather & a light wind employed all shapes
Bore steering E N E second one sail in sight
Lat 46.32 S Long 71.4 W

Friday Dec 18th
Commenced with a fine steady breeze
from the westward steering E N E latter
part a strong breeze ship by the wind
heading N N E spoke the ship forward
& Pilot is too far away employed
towards Lat 45.50 S Long 71.55 W

Saturday Dec 19th
Began with a strong breeze from the north
ward ship by the wind under short sail latter
part more moderate employed washing ship
sails Lat 45.32 S Long 71.4 W

Sunday Dec 20th
Commenced with a strong breeze and
squally from the south steering E latter
part the same ship by the wind heading
E by N ending with rain Lat 45.32 S Long 71.4 W

Commenced with strong southerly wind ship
by the wind heading E by N middle part squally
rain and rain squally latter part pleasant &
calm sounds Lat 55.26 S Long 80.10 W

Thursday Jan 19th
Began with calm and pleasant weather
middle part overcast & fresh breeze latter
part strong wind and squally ship under
double reefed top sails & courses & sails
saw large herring to the westward & no other boats
saw

Friday Jan 20th
Commenced with a gale from the N E by E
too under storm sail. Middle part calm
and a heavy swell from the eastward latter
part light wind from the westward ending
with a breeze from the same steering E N E
pleasant weather Lat 57.08 S Long 78.09 W

Saturday Jan 21st
Commenced with moderate breeze
from S W steering E N E middle
part strong steering N E by E & E
latter part more moderate steering
& N E fine weather saw 5 sails for a while
the ship sounds Lat 56.45 S Long 72.51 W

Sunday Jan 22nd
A moderate breeze from the westward steering E N E middle
part wind hauled to the north blowing heavy but the
