Saturday Jan 23rd

Commenced with a strong breeze from the N.W. showing E.N.E. one sail in sight middle part more moderate steering N.E. pleasant weather latter part calm winds Lat 56.33 Long 65.08

Sunday Jan 24th

Commenced with a calm and fine weather in a part a moderate breeze from the N.E. ship on either tack latter part light wind heading E by S saw five ships decided with the one French from America bound Lat 55.10 S Long 65.41

Monday Jan 25th

Commenced with a calm middle part rain & then fine weather & a pleasant breeze from the southward steering N.E. one sail in sight various employment Lat 55.07 S Long 61.44

Tuesday Jan 26th

Began with a moderate breeze and fine pleasant weather first part from the S. steering N.E. & latter hauled to the N.W. steering the same 5 ships in sight 2 Whalers seen Lat 54.01 Long 60.15 W

Wednesday Jan 27th

Began with moderate weather from the South steering N.E. middle & latter part fine breeze from the N. heading E at 6 A.M. saw in distance several bunches of the Seal Islands took Lat 52.53 Long 58.02 W

Thursday Jan 28th

First part strong breeze from the N.W. heading E one part took to middle & latter part heavy breeze and rain heading N.E. three sails in sight seen no observations Lat Long

Friday Jan 25th

Commenced with a heavy breeze from the South & rain steering N.E. middle part the same latter part fine weather steering N.E. even old no observations

Saturday Jan 30th

Began with moderate weather from the South steering N.W. latter part fine weather heading to the westward ship to the wind heading N.W. pleasant weather various employment Lat 48.16 Long 54.34

Sunday Jan 31st

Commenced with light breeze from the N.W. ship on either tack spoke the ship Corral with of New Bedford 59 tons from the whaler latter part fine strong fine N.W. ship to the wind heading N.E. seen Lat 48.32 S Long 54.12 W

Monday Feb 1st

Commenced with a heavy breeze from the N.W. ship to the wind heading N.E. middle part the same latter part heavy breeze from the westward ship to the wind heading N.W. under close reefed main top sail fore sail to end Lat 48.53 Long 54.00

Tuesday Feb 2nd

Commenced with a strong breeze from the South steering N.W. middle part the same latter part a thick fog saw 13 reg ships the one heading N.E. even N. Lat 48.55 S Long 54.00

Wednesday Feb 3rd

Commenced with stiff breeze & thick fog wind N.W. heading N.E. middle part took westward steering N. latter part light breeze heading the same ship to the wind heading N.E. Lat 48.17 Long 48.12 W

Thursday Feb 4th

Began with fine weather and a moderate breeze varying from N.W. to N. heading the same steering E.N.E. one sail in sight Lat 42.52 S Long 46.08 W
