First part of these 24 hours a gale from E.S.E. with heavy rain under Cloudy Rely wind W.S.W. took in Fore Laid and Fore & Mizzen Top Sails at 3 A.M. luffed too to the S.E. wind W.S.W. & latter part thick rainy weather and a heavy sea saw a ship steering W.N.W.

First part of these 24 hours rainy at 4 A.M. set the S. Sail and Top Sails Course. E.S.E. winds E.S.E. moderate. Middle part under double Rely at daylight made all sail and wore ship to the E.S.E. winds E.S.E. saw a Brig steering west

First part of these 24 hours took in jib and Spanker Course E by S winds S by E thick rainy weather Middle part wind hauled to the North and Cloud very heavy with torrents of rain took in Mizzen Top sail & later Rely Main Top Sails Course E.S.E.

First part of these 24 hours a gale from the S.W. Course E by S with a heavy sea and plenty of rain close Rely the Top Sails took in Mizzen Top Sails Middle part fine clear weather latter part at 5 A.M. took in Fore & Mizzen Top Sails and Fore Sail a heavy gale from E.P. under Cloud Rely Main Top Sails and Fore S.M. Stay sail laying to the E.S.E.

First part of these 24 hours the gale abated kept the ship off E by S and set the Fore Sails at 5 P.M. set Fore & Mizzen Top Sails Cloud Rely Middle part calm latter part light winds from W.S.W. course E by S at 10 P.M. spoke Bk. Borne of Boston 4 days from Nagasaki for Boston all sail out fine weather not stop for letters
