

Remarks On Board Ship of Wayne

Sunday 11th April

First part of these 24 hours fine clear weather wind E. S. E. all sail out to the S. E. Middle and latter part fine clear weather and calm

Long by the 35° 25'

Monday 12th April

Latt by the 39° 0'

First part of these 24 hours calm saw Pinbacks middle and latter part calm

Latt by the 39° 11'

Tuesday 13th April

First part of these 24 hours light wind from the South East E. S. E. all sail out middle and latter part same with calm about the middle

Latt by the 39° 30'

Wednesday 14th April

First part of these 24 hours calm saw a sail at sundown took in top of sails and main sail middle part calm latter part light air from East and bearing East 3 miles distant 50 miles

Latt 39° 17'

Thursday 15th April

First part of these 24 hours light air from the E. S. E. laying South Middle part stood to the E. S. E. latter part calm as a block

Latt 39° 51'

Friday 16th April

First part of these 24 hours calm middle and latter part light winds from the S. E. all sail out to the E. S. E.

Latt 39° 01'

Saturday 17th April

First part of these 24 hours light air 4 sail in sight at sundown land bearing E by S distant 35 miles (Horees) Middle and latter part calm and equally saw a French ship

Latt 39° 19' calm

Sunday 18th April

First part of these 24 hours fine weather and good breeze from the S. E. all sail out to the S. E. E. land bearing E Middle part light wind laying off and on west side of the latter part fine wind from S. S. E. laying up between shores and home 1 h. in sight

Latt 39° 37'

From New Bedford to the S. Ocean

Monday 19th April

First part of these 24 hours fine light air laying to the East at sundown South point bore bearing N. N. W. distant 15 miles Middle part light air latter part light winds from the East all sail out to the S. E.

Latt between 39° & 40°

Tuesday 20th April

First part of these 24 hours fine weather laying S. E. all sail wind East strong at sundown South point bore bearing N. N. W. distant 15 miles Middle part strong winds latter part same all sail out & sail in sight

Latt same

Wednesday 21st April

First part of these 24 hours fresh winds laying S. E. 2 sail in sight at sundown shorter sail to the S. E. Middle part cloudy latter part took ship to the S. E. under top sails and Calves employed at setting up rigging 4 aft

Thursday 22nd April

First part of this day strong wind took ship to the S. E. finished setting up rigging at sundown shortened sail plenty of Pinbacks Middle part under single Ruffs top sails to the S. E. 1 sail in sight

Latt 39° 28'

Friday 23rd April

First part of these 24 hours laying up S. E. wind S. E. at sundown shortened sail 2 sail in sight Middle part took ship to the North at daylight calm latter good breeze from the N. E. W. laying off by E 1 point on North 130°

Saturday 24th April

First part of these 24 hours strong wind all sail out laying N. N. E. at sundown shortened sail Rio West point bearing N. by E distant 25 miles Middle part laying aback off shore latter part took in shore 1 sail in sight we ran down to the East of Rio and round St George and luffed to the wind North wind N. N. W. land 3 miles off looked very pretty on the hills saw plenty Pinbacks
