

# Ship Clifford Wayne from Fairhaven

Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> August 1841

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the S.E. & haying by the wind to the S.W. at 4 o'clock single reefed the top sails with squally weather middle parts set main top gallant sail and fore over reefed top sails latter parts same as first Long 30° 55' W. Lat 11° 30'

H.A. Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours strong wind haying S.W. & W. wind S by E & under single reef & fore & main top sails middle parts set the fore & main top sails and only jib latter parts employed on the rigging at the Mizzen. Dreamed of being at Lloyd's River Long 31° 30' W. Lat 13° 34' South

Friday 6<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours wind fresh from the E by S haying by the wind all sail out middle part moderate latter parts same as in fore & main rigging Long 32° 50' W. Lat 15° 03' South

Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours fresh wind from S by E haying S.W. & S all sail out at 4 o'clock saw Breaches & is not certain what they were middle & latter parts same all sail out wind set Long 32° 25' W. Lat 17° 14' S

Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours fine breeze from E by S haying by the wind to the S.E. all sail out plenty of breeches in sight middle part light wind haying S.W. & W latter parts South saw Humphreys breeches Long 32° 23' W. Lat 19° 25' S

Monday 9<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours strong winds from S.E. & haying S & 4 sail in sight on the wind to the S.E. saw Breaches of weather beams middle parts took in fore & main top sails strong wind haying S.E. & S Long 32° 00' Lat

Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours strong wind course S.E. by S winds S.W. & E all sail out middle parts same latter parts wind from S.W. & E all sail out course S.E. by S wind fine weather and no fish Long 29° 50' W. Lat 23° 53' South

# Via Western Islands towards S. Ocean.

Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> August 1841

These 24 hours begins with strong breeze from the W. & E. all sail out set fore top mast standing sail for the first time course S.E. & 1 brig steering S.E. by E middle parts strong wind latter part had a squall from the S.W. took in top sails and jib sailing course S.E. Long by Sun 27° 40' W. Lat 24° 55' S

Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours moderate and breezy set all sail and S.E. sail course S.E. & 1 brig in sight middle part fine weather at daylight commenced backing out for new sails got them out and fitted to main top sails & main course Long 25° 20' W. Lat 26° 35' S

Friday 13<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours unbending old sails and bending our new ones strong breeze from the S.W. by W. all sail set at sundown took in top gallant sails & only jib middle parts more moderate latter parts set top sails & 1 brig wind S.W. haying by the wind Long 23° 15' W. Lat 28° 00' S

Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours fine weather nearly calm repairing sails. Sail middle & latter parts calm repairing fore & main top sail Long 23° 00' W. Lat 28° 13'

Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours calm finished main top sail and bent it middle parts light air from the east by the wind to the S.E. latter parts fine breeze 1 brig in sight all sail set Long 22° 00' W. Lat 28° 58' S

Monday 16<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours fine clear weather all sail set by the wind S.E. & wind S.E. by S. middle and latter parts S.E. & 1 brig S.E. & 1 sail in sight Long 20° 40' W. Lat 30° 23'

Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> August

First part of these 24 hours strong wind from North course S.E. & 1 brig in sight backing out for water for blugger weather middle parts same latter parts a gale from S.W. took in water boat and has had every thing snug took in fore & main top sails showing a gale with rain and a high sea warned of a black sea at 10 o'clock this day
