First part of these 24 hours fine weather strong wind from S. S. W. course E by N. all sail out Middle part winds more light latter part light wind from the West Long 99° 00 Lat 31° 00

Wednesday 29th September

First part of these 24 hours light wind from the west course S by E all sail out Middle part pleasant wind from S. S. E. latter part strong wind from S. W. all sail out

Long 101° 40 Lat 31° 15

Thursday 30th September 1841

First part of these 24 hours fine weather course E by E all sail out wind S. W. employed at various jobs Middle part clear & calm latter part fine repairing Fore Top Sail

Long 104° 35 Lat 29° 29

Friday 1st October 1841

First part of these 24 hours fine breeze from the S. W. by S all sail out course E by E Middle and latter part strong wind from S. E with light squalls of rain Long 107° 20 Lat 27° 44

Saturday 2nd October

First part of these 24 hours strong wind course E by E all sail out finished the Fore Top Sail and went it stowed the new one away Middle part strong wind latter part single reefed Top Sail

Long 109° 00 Lat 25° 03

Sunday 3rd October

First part of these 24 hours strong wind from S. E course E by E under single Reef at sundown closed Reefs Top Sails and stood Boat Watcher heading to the N. E Middle and latter part strong wind under Reefs to the N. E

Lat 33° 10

Monday 4th October

First part of these 24 hours more moderate heading to N. E by E wind E by S at sundown under short sail Middle and latter part fine light wind from S. E by E employed at all kinds of jobs

Long 109° 22 Lat 22° 20

Coast New Holland

Tuesday 5th October

First part of these 24 hours fine weather all sail out to the N. E employed at repairing sails bent the Main Top Sail and Fore Sail Middle part light wind latter strong breeze from South repairing Main Sail Long 111° 52 Lat 28° 52

Wednesday 6th October

First part of these 24 hours strong wind from South heading to the East all sail out Middle part whaler Doubtless Reefs latter part strong wind from South at 8 sat Main Sail course E by E at getting up cutting pendents

Long 111° 50 Lat 20° 38

Thursday 7th October

First part of these 24 hours under Doubtless Reefs and under course E by E strong wind at sundown took in jib & Main Sail Middle part moderate latter part made all sail saw Blackfish

Long 112° 40 Lat 18° 28

Friday 8th October

First part of these 24 hours fine weather light air from South all sail out course E by E employed on the rigging Middle part course E by E latter part light air from N. W all sail out

Saturday 9th October Lat 17° 44

First part of these 24 hours fine weather course E by E all sail out under S. E employed on the rigging Middle part steering E by E latter part fine all sail out steering N. W saw a Blackfish

Long 114° 01 Lat 16° 17

Sunday 10th October

First part of these 24 hours fine weather light wind from S. E course E by E all sail out at sundown took in Top Sails and courses Middle part same latter part steering N. W all sail out saw 3 porpoises
