

Ship Clifford Wayne M. Court
Monday 15th Oct 1841

First part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather fine breeze from the S E all sail out even at sundown shortened sail Middle parts fine and latter part same. Shared Blackfish without success all sail out
Long 114° 00' Lat 14° 05'

Tuesday 12th Oct

commenced with raising whale at 2 o'clock lowered all the boats whale came up around the ship chased them without success they going to the East at sundown shortened sail with light airs from S E Middle and latter parts fine employed on the Rigger steering. S W
Long about 113° 30' E Lat 13° 15'

Wednesday 13th Oct

First part of this day fine strong breeze from S E all sail out steering W Lat 4th part 3 raised a whale at 5 hours for him but could not get on at dusk 4 mile from the ship came on board took in sail lying aback to the S W in hopes to see him in the morning Middle parts ran of S W 1 hour latter parts strong wind all sail out to the W S W saw nothing
Long 113° 30' E Lat 12° 48'

Thursday 14th Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine breeze lying to the East at 3 o'clock raised a large whale off Weather-More 3 mile off saw him 2 risings and lost him he going to underwave at sundown took in sail to the East Middle and latter parts all sail out strong Trades
Long 113° 00' Lat 13° 38'

Friday 15th Oct

First part of these 24 hours strong Trades all sail out to the S W at sundown tacked ship and took in sail Middle lying to the East latter parts all sail out strong current setting to the S W employed on the Rigger & various other jobs
Proper changes in a day or so
Strong current setting to the S W. about here
Lat 12° 01'

New Holland Storm Whaling
Saturday 16th October 1841

Commenced with fine breeze all sail out to the East at sundown tacked ship to the S W and shortened sail Middle parts light airs and clear latter parts all sail out saw plenty large Blackfish New Moon
Lat 12° 02'

Sunday 17th Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine clear weather all sail out to the East by 8th at sundown shortened sail as usual Middle parts same latter parts calm saw plenty birds & Porpoises & co
Long 113° 02' E Lat 11° 37'

Monday 18th Oct

First part of these 24 hours calm Middle part light airs from the East latter same all sail out sent down Mizen & Mast and sent up a new one
Lat 11° 26'

Tuesday 19th Oct

First part of these 24 hours calm weather employed about the Rigger saw a great number of Finbacks Middle and latter parts light winds from S E lying to the S W
Long 113° 49' Lat 11° 55'

Wednesday 20th Oct

Commenced with light wind all sail out plenty finbacks employed on the Rigger Middle parts all sail out lying to the S W by 8th with fine Trades employed in rather down lower Rigger
Long 112° 50' E Lat 12° 45'

Thursday 21st Oct

Commenced with fine Trades and pleasant and hot employed on the Rigger at sundown tacked ship to the E at 6th and took in sail Middle parts same latter parts Moderate employed on the Rigger & various other jobs
Lat 12° 15'

Friday 22nd Oct

strong wind all sail set at sundown tacked ship to the E at 8th saw Finbacks Middle and latter parts strong winds from S E by 9th lying to the S W employed on the Rigger
Long 112° 24' E Lat 12° 06'
