Saturday 23rd Oct

Strong breezes from S & all sail out to the S W employed on the Rigger saw plenty Finbacks Middle parts under top sails latter parts all sail out to the S W by S. saw nothing Lat 12° 09

Sunday 24th Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine breeze laying to the East by E at sundown took in top Sallant sails as usual Middle parts same latter parts calm saw plenty porpoise Long 114° 49 E Lat 12° 08

Monday 25th Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine breeze laying E by E all sail out of Middle and latter parts light airs and very hot weather the hot altogether Finbacks in sight saw 23 Merchant Ship steering W S W Lat 12° 20 S

Tuesday 26th Oct

First part of this day employed on the Rigger saw a large Breach once at sundown took in top Sallant sails Middle and latter parts light airs from E & all sail out to the E N E finish up with down Lat 12° 40

Wednesday 27th Oct

First part fine trades all sail out at sundown shortened sail as usual took ship to the S S W Middle parts fine latter parts light airs took ship to the E light airs Lat 13° 14

Thursday 28th Oct

Commence with fine trade well to the South laying to the East sun down shortened sail as usual Middle parts light airs latter parts same employed about the Rigger Long 115° 33 E Lat 13° 06

Friday 29th Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine light airs Middle and latter parts same employed on the Rigger Lat 12° 56

On Cruising Ground

Saturday 30th October

First part repairing Main top S Sail and bent light winds from the E N E laying to the S E all sail out at sundown took in top Sallant sails Middle parts same latter light airs and calm Long 117° 00 E Lat 13° 45

Sunday 31st

Commence with very light airs from the East laying to the South all sail out this day nothing at all in sight at sundown took in top S Sails and took ship to the E N E latter parts light airs and calm Dec is the Lat 14° 04

Monday 1st November

Commence with light winds from the E N E all sail out to the E N E at sundown took in sail as usual nothing in sight as usual Middle parts laying aback latter parts fine breeze from the S S E all sail out Long 117° 45 E Lat 14° 15 S

Tuesday 2nd November

First part steering E N E wind S S E saw a Finback at sundown shortened sail as usual Middle and latter parts fine breeze latter steering E W all sail out Long 118° 40 E Lat 13° 40

Wednesday 3rd November

First part of this day steering S W saw plenty Finbacks at sundown took in sail to the East Middle parts strong winds at daylight made sail to the North at 9 A M saw 2 whales to the 10 lowered and struck 1 to the West Boat and drew and missed another struck 1 to the Starboard Boat and parted the line came on Board and got dinner last night because of Mary and so on and being to the ship E Thursday 4th November Long 117° 30 Lat 13° 12
ought to have whale to day we lowered again for the whales and missed at the West Boat and struck at the Starboard Boat and drew and came on Board at sundown lowered again did not get near them took in sail to the S E wind S S W Middle parts fine with strong breeze latter part same Long 118° 06 Lat 13° 15
