

Ship Clifford Wayne at Lombok

Wednesday 17th November

First part of this day wind South all sail out course E by S at sundown Banditti Island bearing E by E 6 miles steering in for the East passage Middle part calm latter part light air and calm and squally with the aid of the current we got within 5 miles of Mandaity

Thursday 18th November

First part calm strong current setting in at sundown Mandaity bearing S W Rally Peak E by W with a calm Middle part light air & calm steering E by E for the town current in our favour at daylight saw the town ahead in and could not come to anchor for it was against the laws for any whaler to anchor here from the Rajah at 9 stood out down the Straights with the wind North

Friday 19th November

First wind from the North at sundown got out of the Straights bound to Allis Straights Middle part light air and calm latter part Allis Straights in sight

Saturday 20th Lat 9° 00

First Part Calm and light air steering in for the East point of Lombok at sundown up to the point 5 miles from Pajow Middle part light air at 8 P.M. came to anchor at Pajow in 10 fathoms Wooded and Watered at this place Wednesday took our anchor and went up to Bally for recruits & we came to anchor in 12 fathoms Lombok Peak bearing N W there we got small potatoes & Potatoes &c

Sunday 21st November

First part of these 24 hours squally with plenty of rain Middle part light air at 4 A.M. got under weigh and stood out with light air got outside of the point the current took us inside again with little or no wind the rest of the time employed in beating with light winds from South E & W

Off Lombok Bound South
Tuesday 30th November

Employed in beating out through the Straights with light air from the S W S & S E Middle part we carried in again latter part of the night lowered boat and stood off at 8 miles 3 large whales 16 miles from the land bound for them and struck to the starboard boat equally with plenty of rain from Java Island bearing N distant 16 miles
Wednesday 1st December
First part strong wind at 2 O'clock took the whale alongside and got much throat plenty of rain Middle part fine at daylight commenced cutting for the No. 1 and head in squalls of rain from Java in sight finished cutting and commenced working

Thursday 2nd December

First part of these 24 hours fine weather employed in working Middle and latter part same Island of Mandalwood in sight 12 miles distant Lat 9° 45

Friday 3rd December

First part of these 24 hours wind N E 100 laying to the South saw a large whale saw him again of weather from 6 miles off Middle and latter part working with plenty squalls of rain

Saturday 4th December

First part finished working and changed the decks and washed off and changed at sundown took in to 3 sails heading to the South wind from the West Middle and latter part rain light wind & strong wind from S E W to N E W

Sunday 5th December

First part of these 24 hours rain split the jib and bent another under top sails with plenty of rain thunder and lightning at sundown Doubled Reef Middle and latter part light wind and squally from the S W N W new tacking ship to the S W & South Lat 10° 50'
