Monday 5th December 1841

First part strong wind from S.W. under
top sails and courses to the S.W. Middle parts Drabed Reef
at daylight strong wind commenced Steer in Down Main Mast
Long 118° 05' E Lat 10° 03'

Tuesday 7th

First part quite rugged at 6 finished
steering down 68th of Stern Oil ~~finishing~~ going to the
S.E. latter part to the S.W. took in waste Boat and
repaired her moved the Cook Stove &c

Long 118° 00' E Lat 9° 53'

Wednesday 8th

First part of them 24 hours all sail
out to the East of weather saw Pinbacks Middle parts
five latter parts all sail out to the South painted Mast
Boat and repaired Spanker

Lat 10° 50' S

Thursday 9th December

First part of them 24 hours
squalls of rain bent the Spanker all sail out to
the South wind W by S Middle & latter parts all sail out
to the South wind from West repairing Mainsail

Long 118° 15' Lat 11° 36' S

Friday 10th December

First part of these 24 hours fine
finished Main sail bent him all sail out heading South
Middle and latter parts fine all sail out repairing jib

Long 118° 30' E Lat 11° 50'

Saturday 11th December

First part of them 24 hours fine weather all sail out to
the South wind W by S Middle parts same latter parts
Balm and light air heading to the W or W

Long East 114° 40' Lat 11° 40'

Sunday 12th December

Light air from the S.W. W
all sail out to the South at dark took over to the West all sail
out latter parts light air from S.S.W. Lat 11° 30'

Monday 13th

First part of them 24 hours
light air from S.W. heading to the West Middle parts fine
at 2 P.M. raised a large Whale very slow at 8 A.M. however
for them and they pursued the Boat and took off chase them
until 20 P.M. afternoon without success No Wh

Tuesday 14th Dec

First part chasing whale at
8 came on Board and stood to the West light air at 4 raised
a large whale going to the East however and stood 1 to the
West Boat hid on 5 minutes and drawn chase them until
dark came on Board took in top & sails Middle parts light wind
latter parts nearly calm at 8 A.M. raised a large whale going
such however and chase him all the forenoon without success
could not come up with him Lat by Dec 11° 50'

Wednesday 15th December

First part calm repairing jib
Middle parts calm latter parts calm repairing Fore Sail
New Moon Lat 11° 37' S

Thursday 16th

First part light air and calm repair
Fore Sail saw plenty Grampuses Middle calm latter parts all
sail out with light wind from the S.E. Lat

Friday 17th

First part of them 24 hours fine weather
from S.E. all sail out to the S.W. at sundown took in top & sails
Middle parts light wind latter parts all sail out saw a ship
cutting Long 111° 50' E Lat 12° 16' S
