

Ship Clifford Wayne

Monday 10th January 1842

First part of these 24 hours calm and squally all around. Middle part fine till daylight commenced strong from Main North wind S S E

Lat 16° 46'

We find the current setting to the South

Tuesday 11th January

Commenced with rainy squally weather wind S S E at 5 P.M. finished strong from S S E of oil Middle part laying to the S W under Top Sails Middle part fine latter part strong winds from the South

Long 109° 35' East Lat 16° 20' S

Wednesday 12th January

Commenced with strong winds from the South laying to the West employed at breaking out between decks at sundown Doubled Reefed the Top Sails and Hoisted ship to the East latter part all sail out and fine

Lat 16° 15' S

Thursday 13th January

First part of this day fine all sail out to the West wind S S W at sundown took in Top Sallant Sails Middle part more ship to the S S E latter part all sail out

Lat 16° 35' S

Friday 14th Jan

First part fine all sail out to the S S E by 9 employed at day repairing fore sail at sundown took in light sails wind S W by S Middle part same latter part all sail out to the S

Lat 17° 23' S

Saturday 15th Jan

From all sail out to the South wind W S W at sundown took in Top S Sails Middle part fine latter part very pleasant all sail out to the South

Lat 18° 20' South

On Conceiving Broune

Sunday 16th Jan 1842

First part of these 24 hours fine and pleasant. Middle part same latter fine all sail set to the South winds NW & W S W

Lat 19° 20'

Monday 17th Jan

Commenced with fine pleasant weather all sail out Middle part took in Top S Sails heading South Wind W S W Middle part light winds latter part strong wind from S W by W. repairing fore Top Sail

Lat 20° 34'

Tuesday 18th Jan

First part strong winds from S W Top Sail and bent it at sundown took in sail as usual Middle part fine took ship to the West latter part all sail out wind S S W employed setting up Main & M. Top Mast Stays

Lat 21° 13' South

First quarter

Wednesday 19th Jan

Fine weather all sail out to the West wind S S W at sundown shortened sail Middle part cloudy & clear latter part all sail out laying W by S wind S S by W

Long by ship 111° 04' E Lat 21° 35' S

Thursday 20th January

Strong wind from the S S W took in Top Sallant Sails by the wind to the West and Doubled Reefed the Top Sails Middle part same latter part took in Main sail

Lat 22° 07' S

Friday 21th Jan

Strong wind from the S S E under Doubled Reef to the S W. Middle & latter part strong winds from S S E to South employed at various small jobs under single reefed Top Sails

Lat 22° 50' S
