Thursday 3rd February 1842.

Brewer first part strong Middle part Moderate latter part all sail out fine pleasant weather
tacked ship to the S.E. &.

Lat 25° 14' South

Friday 4th Feb.

Fine weather all sail out to the S.E. & wind South Middle part fine saw a Bk standing to the N.W. latter part all sail out to the S.W. fine weather

Lat 25° 13' S

Saturday 5th Feb.

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail out to the S.W. wind S.E. at sundown shortened sail Middle part latter part all sail out to the East Lat 25° 10'

Sunday 6th Feb.

Began with fine weather and fine breeze from the S.E. all sail out to the East saw 1 sail steering to the West at sundown took in sail Middle part fine latter part all sail out to the S.E. & W. and fine weather Long 105° 45' E Lat 25° 33' S

Monday 7th Feb.

Fine weather wind S.E. & E laying to the S.W. Middle and latter part very fine all sail out S.W. Long 104° 36' E Lat 26° 24' S

Tuesday 8th Feb.

Fine pleasant weather all sail out to the S.W. saw nothing as usual Middle part same latter part tacked ship to the East employed at repairing Mizen Top Sail Long 105° 45' E Lat 26° 38' S

Wednesday 9th February

Commenced with fine weather wind S.E. & all sail out to the East Middle part same latter part tacked ship to the S.W. all sail out strong wind from the S.E. & E Lat 26° 38' S

West Coast New Holland

Chronometer about 70 Miles out to the East up to June 18th New Moon

Thursday 10th February

Strong wind from the S.E. & all sail out to the South Sundown Doubled Mizen the Top Sail latter part strong wind laying S.E. & W Lat 27° 42' South

Friday 11th Feb.

Commenced with fine weather pleasant breezes from the S.E. & Middle and latter part fine carrying sail to the South Lat 29° 10'

Saturday 12th Feb.

Fine weather laying South wind S.E. & E trying to get to the East Middle part same latter part strong wind laying to the S.E. & E. under Top & Courses Long 106° 12' East Lat 28° 34' South

Sunday 13th February

Fine weather with fresh Breezes from the S.E. laying to the S.E. & E Middle part under Doubled Mizen Top Sail latter part laying East Lat 27° 43'

Monday 14th Feb.

Fine and pleasant wind South all sail out to the S.E. & Middle part fine light winds latter part fine breeze from the W.S.W. steering S.E. employed at setting of M.S. stay Long 108° 00' E Lat 28° 00' S

Tuesday 15th Feb.

Commenced with fine weather all sail out steering S.E. & wind West at 2 P.M. saw a ship the Factor of Port Phillip at 3 raised sperm Whales lowered and struck to the Larboard Boat at 6 took him alongside and took him sail to the S.E. & E. winds South Middle part fine at daylight Commenced cutting at 10 got all in the boat was took in and raised more whales about 11 however for them

Long 108° 20' E Lat 27° 40'
