Tuesday March 22nd 1841

Fine weather all sail
out to the East & East at sundown took in sail latter
part all sail out under Studding Sails Lat 28° 40'

Wednesday March 23rd

Commenced with strong winds
laying to the East under 2 Reef Top Sails the 3 Brothers
in sight Middle part hanging by the wind under Studding Sails
latter part steering N N E Lat 26° 28'

Thursday March 24th

Strong winds and fine weather
Coursed N at sundown took in sail latter part fine
weather all sail out Course N N E Lat 25° 16'

Friday March 25th

Fine weather all sail out
Course N saw a ship at sundown took in sail to the N W
the other ship took in to the East Middle part fine latter part
all sail out Lat 24° 13'



Full Moon

Saturday March 26th

Commenced with fine Breeze
All sail out course N N E at sundown raised a large
whale 1 mile off however he went down some on Board
took in sail to the East Middle part fine latter part steering
to the N W Lat 23° 34'

Sunday March 27th

First part of these 24 hours fine
winds from N W laying West all sail out at sundown took
in sail to the East took in sail latter part strong winds from
the South Long by Obs 111° 41' E 23° 41' South

out to the East at sundown took in sail latter part took in
to the West wind S S W Lat 23° 54'

Tuesday March 29th

Commenced with strong winds
laying to the West saw plenty Blackfish at sundown took in sail
latter part fine latter part all sail out Lat 23° 49'

Wednesday March 30th

Fine weather all sail out to the
North spoke Ship Huntress Capt Seber New Bedford 7 m out
180 m from 2 night whals at sundown took in sail to the N saw a
Breach Mouth & latter part fine weather all sail out
No Letter Lat 23° 49'

Thursday March 31st

Commenced with fine weather
all sail out to the East at sundown took in sail to the N at daylight
made all sail & more ship to the N W Lat 22° 50'

Friday April 1st

Fine weather and a smooth sea
all sail set wind South laying N N W saw a Breach long way
off at sundown took in sail to the West latter part under top sails
strong winds from N N E & S laying by the wind to the West
Lat 23° 13'

Saturday April 2nd

Strong winds and rough Course
and Top Sails out to the West at sundown took in sail to the East
Middle & latter part a gale more ship to the N W
Lat 23° 12' South

Sunday April 3rd

First part a gale under Cloud
Middle part same latter part set the
Fore sail latter part strong winds
began a little for N N E Lat 23° 26' South
