

Ship Clifford Wayne at Copang

Monday 27th June

Fine weather all sail out tack
Ship to the N E Full Down bearing E S E. Stars bearing
West End W by N Middle parts bearing N E latter parts steering
down and finished light wind. Lat 9° 44' South

Tuesday 28th June

First part calm at 4 strong wind
from the S E. part of main of sail sheet Middle parts
same weather latter parts backing for the Bay of Copang

Wednesday 29th June

Strong trade backing to S E
of the Bay of Copang lat sundown got site of the town Middle
parts strong winds and light winds beating up at 8 o'clock came
too anchor in 20 fathoms water abreast the flag staff
and furled the sails found the S group of B. in shells of
difficult here it being rugged could not find out of station
and plenty pumpkins got Part B letters by the S. to a whizz

Wednesday 6th July 1842

Latter part of this day fine light
winds at daylight watch came aboard & took the anchor for Putnam
steering along by the land to the N E

Thursday 7th July 1842

Commences with light winds backing
to S E, of 4 on the land winds at 11 W saw a B. ship's steering
at 12 o'clock Middle part light winds & calm latter parts light
airs saw the small island very smooth employed in searching harbor
side wind light from the S W getting along very slow

Friday 8th July 1842

Light airs and smooth finish
painting harbor side ship steering for the point this side Putnam
at sundown 8 miles from the point Middle parts strong tide made no
head way at daylight same place as at sundown

Friday 8th July

Latter parts fine breeze during in for
Putnam at 11 o'clock came too in 13 fathoms water with the Island of
to Putnam bearing N W by W. and a little to the West of the Putnam
we mended & got plenty Yams & few Potatoes & Oranges and painted
the Land & named of H. A. S. being up to ~~the~~ Putnam
H. A. S.

Thursday 14th July 1842

at daylight weighed anchor and made
sail to the S W. employed at clearing the docks lashing
anchors and wind of the land

Friday 15th July

Commences with light winds
from the W S W all sail out the S W saw plenty blackfish
and 3 B. Middle parts wind the land steering S W latter
parts fine breeze Long 122° 39' Lat 10° 36'

Saturday 16th July

Fine winds from S E all sail
at 10 the S S W repairing S. S. at sundown saw bearing
W by W just in light took in light sails Middle fine latter
parts steering West all sail out saw plenty timber
Lat 11° 47' South

Sunday 17th July

Fine winds from S E course West
at sundown took in sail and huffed too to the South Middle parts
light airs and fine daylight made all sail course W by W
Lat 11° 45' South

Monday 18th July

Commences with light winds course
W by W Middle parts fine latter all sail out course W S W
saw nothing remarkable
Lat 11° 51' S
