

Ship Clifford Wayne On The

Thursday 19th July 1842

Commenced with fine pleasant weather all sail out to the West repairing sails Middle by the wind to the West latter all sail out to the West Long 115° 40' E Lat 12° 04'

Wednesday 20th July

Fine weather fine winds all sail out course S W at sundown took in top & sails repairing sails as usual Middle parts fine latter same all sail out steering S W Long 116° 59' E Lat 12° 55' S

Thursday 21st July

Fine weather all sail out course S W repairing sails at sundown took in top & sails to the S W pleasant weather and has been since leaving port as ever was in the N. Ocean but no whales a few Pinbacks and Grampuses Middle fine latter parts all sail out course S W by S Long 117° 55' East Lat 10° 20' S

Friday 22nd July

Fine weather and fine breeze saw Pinbacks employed in repairing old sails at sundown took in top & sails and duffel too to the S W Middle had a heavy shower of rain latter parts fine all sail out course S W repairing Long 114° 51' E Lat 10° 35' South

Saturday 23rd July

First part of this day fine weather all sail out S W Middle & latter parts calm No whales seen till 4 o'clock till day 16th S

Sunday 24th July

Fine weather and calm commenced melting block Middle parts took a dose of Galap fine weather latter same saw Pinbacks and after 4 o'clock quite smart began a latter at 11th M 8th Long by 12th S

Lat 12° 19' South

Northern Ground. N. Ocean

Monday 25th July 1842

Commenced with light airs and nearly calm course S W Middle parts fine struck a pelican and lost latter parts squally with rain No whales

Tuesday 26th July

Strong squalls raised the top sails some rain and rugged Middle had swell from the South latter about the same Long by 6th 112° 24' E Lat 14° 50'

Wednesday 27th

Strong winds under Double Reef took ship to the North Middle & latter strong breezes laying N E by E under Double Reef Long 112° 35' East Lat 14° 15' S

Thursday 28th July

More Moderate fine weather made no sail at sundown same latter fine weather all sail out course S W saw nothing at all

Friday 29th July

Commenced with fine weather all sail out course S W took out 2 Pump found it cracked very Bad then found it at sundown took in light sails lay by till the S W for whales Middle parts light squall of rain latter heavy swell from the South all sail out course S W Lat 14° 24' South

Saturday 30th July

Heavy swell and cloudy all sail out course S W saw nothing at sundown took in sail to the South Middle parts cloudy and squally latter parts same plenty of rain after strong wind blowing S W No whales
