

Ship Clifford Wayne On a

Friday 12th August 1842

First of this day fair breeze from East by the wind to the S.E. at sundown took in sail Middle and latter parts lying E.S.E. wind at E. painted Mast Boat Long 110° 37' E Lat 15° 00' S

Saturday 13th August

First part of these 24 hours quite good weather lying to the E.S.E. at sundown took in sail Middle and latter parts lying East latter same same in back Long 112° 10' S Lat 15° 25'

Sunday 14th August

First part of this day fine all sail out to the E by E wind North Middle under short sail latter part wore ship to the West saw nothing Long 115° 15' S Lat 15° 15' S

Monday 15th August

Commenced with a rain squall from the N.W. making S.E. Middle parts took in sail as usual to the East Lat 14° 52'

Tuesday 16th

Commenced with squally rainy weather lying to the East wind South Middle and latter parts No Better Lat 13° 30' S

Wednesday 17th

Squalls of rain as usual lying to the E.E. wind S.E. at sundown took in sail as usual and wore ship to the S.W. Middle parts fine latter parts first rate weather all sail set course W.S.W. Made a new Mat for Main Top Sail yard Long 113° 46' East Lat 13° 40' S

Thursday 18th August 1842

First part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather all sail out course W.S.W. breaking out after hatch at sundown took in sail to the E.E. Middle parts fine latter parts lying weather course W.S.W. No Obd.

Friday 19th August

First part of this day saved off fine course W.S.W. for Whales at sundown took in sail Middle and latter parts fine nice breeze all sail out to the S.W. saw Pinbacks dreamed of seeing Hope Ann Long 111° 50' East Lat 14° 15'

Saturday 20th August

First part of this day fine pleasant weather all sail out to the S.W. employed in refitting Back Stays at sundown took in sail Middle parts fine latter same Long 110° 50' E Lat 14° 46' S.

Sunday 21st August

First part of this day all sail out to the S.W. at sundown doubled reefed Middle and latter parts fresh breezes from the S.E. by S Long 109° 53' E Lat 15° 57' S

Monday 22nd August

Commenced with strong trade wind under reefed sails & courses to the S.W. Middle under short sail latter fine all sail out to the S.W. repairing old Boat Long 109° 30' E Lat 16° 38'

Tuesday 23rd August

Like yesterday weather all sail out carrying Main & Back Stays at sundown took in sail Middle parts calm latter light winds from the S.E. Long 109° 30' E Lat 17° 15' S
