

Ship Clifford Wayne On A

Wednesday 24th Augst

Small breeze all sail out laying
W S W at sundown took in sail and backed ship to the E S E
latter part repairs to Boat, &c. Lat 17° 25'

Thursday 25th

Commenced with pretty good weather
laying to the East Middle part squally latter part heading
to the S S W under Double Reef Lat 17° 34' South

Long 107° 30' East Lat 17° 34' South

Friday 26th August

Commenced with fair weather laying
S S W Middle part same latter part of this day saw a Vintail
laying S W all sail out Lat 15° 30' S

Saturday 27th

Fair weather heavy swell from
the South at night took in sail laying W S W Middle part latter
part fine weather all sail out to the S W by W

Long 105° 30' E Lat 15° 40'

Sunday 28th Augst

Fine weather and no fish all sail
sat by the wind to the S W by W at sundown took in sail
Middle part latter part no alteration Lat 15° 20' South

Monday 29 Augst

First part of this day beautiful
no fish Middle part fine latter part first rate
Long 103° 50' Lat 20° 02'

Tuesday 30th Augst

First part fine fairer old Main
top Sail at sundown took in sail and backed ship to the
East Middle part latter part fine pleasant weather
thinking what fine time they have at home
Long Lat 20° 15'

Cruise of the South

Wednesday 31st August 1842

Commenced with fine pleasant weather all
sail sat to the E S E with light winds at work on the rigging
middle part same latter part all sail out to the E S E
Long 105° 40' East Lat 19° 13' South

Thursday 1st September

Commenced very fine Middle pleasant
latter all sail sat laying E S E saw Porpoises uncertain what
they were Lat 15° 33' South

Friday 2nd September

Commenced fine light winds &c
at sundown took in top Gallant sails Middle part latter strong winds from
the S E by E laying to the E S E with a few squalls of rain
Long 117° 51' Lat 15° 40'

Saturday 3rd September

First part strong winds from S E under
top Sails to the E S E at sundown Double Reefed latter strong winds
laying E S E Long 115° 07' East Lat 17° 10' S

Sunday 4th September

Commenced more moderate for the wind to the
E S E at sundown took in sail no whales nor have not seen one for
3 days Middle part latter part first rate all sail out course North
Long 119° 46' Lat 16° 32'

Monday 5th Sept

Commenced fine course & all
sail out at sundown took in sail to the East Middle
part latter part first rate all sail out by the
wind to the E S E wind East
Long 110° 30' Lat 15° 15'
