Tuesday 6th September

Commenced fine pleasant
weather all sail out at sundown took in sail to the East
Middle & latter parts all sail made Course West
Long Lat 14° 15' South

Wednesday 7th September

Commenced fine morning down for
& aft all sail set Course West Middle strong breeze latter
under Top Sails & courses Long 109° 21' E Lat 13° 23'

Thursday 8th September

Commenced with fresh winds
& a high swell at sundown took in sail to the SE &
Middle & latter parts strong winds employed deck the rigging
Lat 13° 40'

Friday 9th September

Commenced with strong wind
from the E & S by the wind to the SE & Middle under
short sail latter all sail out Lat 11° 11'

Saturday 10th Sept

Commenced fine getting rigging
breezes & at sundown took in sail Middle parts fine
latter parts all sail out to the SE &
Long 110° 18' East Lat 9° 55' South

Sunday 11th September

Commenced fine all sail
set to the SE & with a fine breeze & no whales
Middle & latter parts fine weather & no whales to be
found all sail out
Long 110° 00' E Lat 10° 04' South

In The Indian Ocean

Monday 12th September 1842

Commenced fine all sail out to the
SE Middle & latter same Lat 10° 44'

Tuesday 13th September

Fine fresh breeze from the
SE & S all sail out to the SE Middle & latter
same as usual Long 109° 15' E Lat 10° 45' S

Wednesday 14th September

Commenced fine strong breeze
spoke ship Heroine of Fairhaven Capt Smith 16th March
apt 2100 400 Sperm bound to Anjer sent Letters
to Father & Hope Ann Middle parts strong wind
latter same hugging by the wind to the SE & W
Lat 10° 10' South

Thursday 15th September

Commenced with strong trades laying
by the wind to the SE & W Current setting SE & W
Middle and latter parts same saw a Blk whale
Long 107° 00' East Lat 12° 20'

Friday 16th September

Commenced with strong winds under
Top Sails & courses to the SE & W wind SE & E
repaired main Top Sallant sail Middle parts hugging
by the wind to the SE & W latter all sail out fine weather
Long 107° 36' East Lat 12° 00' S

Saturday 17th September

Commenced fine all sail set by the
wind to the SE & W Middle & latter parts fine
no whales nothing to do other by
the Sat such as it is
Long 118° 30' East Lat 10° 50' S
