

Ship Clifford Wayne On A

Wednesday 23 November 1842

Commenced with light airs all sail out to the S W Middle Calm latter part strong wind and strong current to the W W Dredge

Long 109° 20 East Lat 13° 18 S

Thursday 24th November

Commenced with strong winds all sail out to the S W stowed down 100 of S Oil in the sun & night took in top Sails Middle & latter parts very ragged

Longitude 107° 51 Lat 14° 02

Friday 25th November

Commenced with strong winds under top sails & courses to the S W Middle & latter parts same

Long 106° 35 Lat 15° 10 South

Saturday 26th

First Middle & latter parts strong winds & heavy by the wind to the W S W

Long 105° 15 Lat 15° 37 South

Sunday 27th

Commenced in quite fine all sail out to the S E Middle parts same latter winds hauled back to the S W all sail out to no whales

Long 104° 47 Lat 15° 51 South

Monday 28th November

Commenced with fresh winds by the wind to the S W by N all sail out Middle & latter about the same

Long 103° 24 Lat 16° 48 South

Tuesday 29th November

Commenced as usual Middle & latter Strong courses

Long 102° 49 Lat 17° 58

Wednesday 30th November

Commenced with fresh winds put 2 cups in top sails by the wind S W by S Middle & latter parts same

Long by Ship Lat 19° 03 South

Unlucky Cruise

December 1st 1842

Commenced more moderate hazy by the wind S S W Middle & latter parts more moderate quite fine weather

Long 110° 55 East Lat by Obs 21° 10 South

Friday 2 December

Commenced fine with fair Breezes from S E by E by the wind to the South Middle rather squally latter under single reef to the S W by S

Long 100° 26 East Lat 21° 30 South

Saturday 3rd December

Commenced with strong trade and squally heading S S W Middle S W latter S W by S; saw a finback

Long 98° 47 East Lat 23° 56

Sunday 4th December

Commenced quite fine by the wind S S W at sundown single reefed the top Sails Middle fine latter same under top Sails & courses jib & flannel

Long 97° 02 Lat 24° 28

Monday 5th December

Commenced fine weather & clear by the wind to the S by W Middle same latter all sail out fine light winds

Long 97° 19 E Lat 25° 50

Tuesday 6th December

Commenced fine all sail out took ship to the S E wind S S W Middle Calm, light airs latter parts saw a ship steering N by strong winds

Long 98° 06 Lat 26° 06

Wednesday 7th Dec

Commenced strong winds from the South under Double Reef to the S E Middle more moderate latter all sail out to the S E fine weather

Long 98° 33 East Lat 26° 06
