Sunday January 15th

Commenced from light air from NW corner
all sail out Middle & latter parts wind NW & W hazy
wind course NW & Long by Ace 168° 50' Var 1 point Lat 35° 49'

Monday Jan 16th

Commenced with strong winds from
NW & W by the wind to the NW & at sundown thick and rainy
Middle part some latter part fine wind & W course NW & all sail
Long by Ace 169° 55' E Lat 34° 57'

Tuesday Jan 17th

Commenced with light air repaired
Mizzen top sail Middle part calm latter part began to blow
at 4 past 9 raised a shoal of 8 Whales at 11 hauled and struck
1 to the L B 1 to the W B 1 to the S B and 1 to the W B at 11 took
them alongside 1 sail in sight

Lat 34° 20'

Wednesday 18th

First part of this day squally took
over 3 whales alongside and got ready for cutting at 6 finished 1 and
took in the head at sundown took in sail and made all fast saw
Middle part blowing fresh from the NW & E at daylight commenced
cutting the other two at 12 finished

Thursday 19th

First part of this day rainy down
nothing at dark started the fires and cleared away Middle part
diversely latter part made all sail wind strong from NW & W course
NW & Long by Ace 171° 05' Lat 34° 22'

Friday 20th

Commenced more moderate at 3
saw the three Kings bearing E by S distant 12 miles thick and
hazy Middle part strong wind latter part moderate course E by S
all sail out Boiling

Long by Ace 173° 55' E Lat 33° 01'

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Saturday 21st January

First part of this day cloudy
with light winds Middle part finished Boiling latter part
strong wind took in the Gallant sail heading NW & E wind ESE
Long 176° 50' East Lat 32° 00'

Sunday 22nd January

First part of this day blowing
strong doubled Reefed the top sail which ESE by the wind to the
NE and cloudy Middle part same took in jib & spanker
latter under single Reef to the NW & E winds SE & E & sailing
NW & NE

Monday 23rd January

Commenced with strong wind and
cloudy under single Reef to the NW & E wind the same Middle and
latter all sail out under the same took in ship to the S

Long by Ace 175° 18' East

Lat 31° 06'

Tuesday 24th Jan

First part of this day strong breezes
all sail out under NW & E by S at sundown took in top & sails Middle
part very strong breezes from S & E course East latter part under
South Sea the S Top Sailing Sail and main Moyal

Long by Ace 179° 04' West

Lat 31° 26'

Wednesday 25th Jan

First part of this day strong winds and
rugged wind S & W course East at 4 saw French Rocks bearing
E by S distant 10 miles got altitude Rock bearing S & distant 10 miles bore
Long 175° 40' West Middle part strong breezes and rugged latter
the same course S & E
