

# Ship Clifford Wayne Bound

Sunday March 12<sup>th</sup> 1843

Commences with fine breeze from the N. E. all sail out to the N. E. & S. E. Middle parts calm and squally with plenty of rain wind N. E. & S. E. and west corner N. E. & S. E.  
Long 148° 00' West Lat 15° 38'

Monday March 13<sup>th</sup> 1843

Commences with light air and calm water N. E. & S. E. from N. W. Middle parts calm latter fine breeze from the N. E. & S. E. corner N. E. & S. E.  
Long 147° 13' West Lat 15° 00'

Tuesday March 14<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine breeze from the N. E. all sail out by the wind to the East Middle and latter parts squally N. E. & S. E.  
Long 145° 40' West Lat 13° 12' South

Wednesday March 15<sup>th</sup>

Commences fine all sail out with fine little breeze from the N. E. & S. E. sail in sight employed in chasing S. E. & S. W. Middle and latter parts light air latter parts heading N. E. & S. E.  
Long 145° 40' West Lat 13° 00'

Thursday March 16<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine weather and no wind the S. E. in sight Middle and latter parts fine weather all sail out by the wind, wind East by South  
Lat 12° 20'

Friday March 17<sup>th</sup>

Fine weather trades set in all sail out heading N. E. & S. E. Middle and latter parts wind N. E. & S. E. by the wind  
Long 145° 07' West Lat 11° 00'

Saturday March 18<sup>th</sup>

Commences fine weather wind N. E. & S. E. by the wind N. E. & S. E. Middle and latter parts light wind by the wind from N. E. & S. E. to N. E. & S. E. wind from the Eastward have not seen anything since leaving the islands  
Long 145° 00' West Lat 10° 12'

# On The Line For Whales

Sunday March 19<sup>th</sup> 1843

First part of this day light wind from the N. E. & S. E. by the wind starboard looks Middle and latter parts same  
Long 145° 04' Lat 9° 10' S

Monday March 20<sup>th</sup>

First part of this day nearly calm takes by the N. E. & S. E. trying to get further to the East Middle and latter light air and changeable winds from N. E. & S. E. by the wind  
Long 145° 17' West Lat 8° 40'

Tuesday March 21<sup>st</sup>

Commences with light wind heading N. E. & S. E. parts squally fresh breeze from N. E. & S. E. by the wind latter parts fresh breeze took in S. W. by S. E. and by the wind  
Long 146° 00' Lat 7° 31'

Wednesday March 22<sup>nd</sup>

First part of this day strong breeze from N. E. & S. E. at 4 o'clock ship to the N. E. & S. E. employed at turning up back stays Middle and latter fine breeze from N. E. & S. E. by the wind to the N. E. & S. E. all sail in sight  
Lat 6° 10'

Thursday March 23<sup>rd</sup>

Commences fine wind as last 24 hours by the wind to the N. E. & S. E. all sail out Middle parts no alteration latter parts calm with squalls of rain further Main Top Sail Set  
No other

Friday March 24<sup>th</sup>

Commences squally with no wind and cloudy Middle parts calm and squally latter parts fine all sail out with a fine breeze from the N. E. & S. E.  
Long Lat 5° 33'

Saturday March 25<sup>th</sup>

First part of this day fine weather and fine breeze from N. E. & S. E. all sail out Middle and latter parts fine all sail out by the wind to the North wind N. E. & S. E.  
Lat 7° 18'
