light winds all sail out to the S by W under 12 sails

Monday 29th May

Commenced with fine Breeze from the N by
all sail out by the wind N by E at sundown took in sail latter
part made sail by the wind N by E
Long 173° 00 East Lat 28° 51 N

Tuesday 30th May

First part of this day strong winds
from the N by E under 12 sails and Courses at sundown took in sail
Middle part made sail by the wind S by E repaired fore top sail
