came on board saw no more at 8 o'clock the ship Martha of Newport left
Doverport 10 months out 1000 lbs of sperm at sundown took in sail Middle
foggy at daylight the same made sail and men ship to the South at
raised whale going quick to the west Lawrence without success came on
board saw a carcass fine weather all sail out to the South wind W & W

First part of this day fine weather with
breeze of fog passing all sail out course W & W at sundown
took in sail Middle part fine course West latter part hauled
to the wind SW since 10 o'clock under top Sails one

Long 167° 16 East Lat 29° 54

Saturday June 10th

Commences fine strong breeze from S & E
the wind SW Middle part took in sail latter fine made all sail
and tacked ship to the East Long 168° 04 East Lat 29° 52

Sunday June 11th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather
all sail out to the East wind S & E 2 ships in sight at sundown took
in sail latter part light winds all sail set to the East

Monday June 12th

First part of this day tacked ship
to the SW all sail out light winds at sundown took in sail
latter part all sail out to the West Long 167° 38 Lat 30° 05

Tuesday June 13th

First part of these 24 hours fine by the wind to the
West at sundown took in sail Middle part fine latter part fine breeze
all sail out to the S & E wind SW
