

Ship Clifford Wayne  
Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June

First part of this day quite fine by the wind S.E. wind S.W. Middle part some at daylight made sail strong breeze broke out Main Hatch between decks & side for stowing down 50<sup>th</sup> Lat 30° 15'

Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June

First part of this day finished stowing down except 1 cask & sail in sight at sundown took in sail Middle part more ship to the West latter under Double Reef strong wind No Long Lat 30° 20'

Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June

First part of this day took in from the Mizzen - Top Sails were ship to the S.E. wind hauled S.W. flying by the wind 1<sup>st</sup> in sight under that sail plenty of rain Middle part some latter part strong wind under 2<sup>nd</sup> reef Top Sails to the S.E. Long 164° 43' East Lat 29° 42'

Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> June

First part of this day strong wind from S.W. under Double Reef to the S.E. at sundown took in sail more ship to the West Middle part plenty of rain Lightning and a heavy squall from S.W. took in from sail under 2<sup>nd</sup> reef Main Top Sails latter part being No. 210

Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June

First part of this day cleared of wind hauled to the North made sail 1<sup>st</sup> in sight by the wind West at Middle part latter strong wind from S.W. under Top Sails to the S.W. Lat 30° 06'

Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> July

Commenced with strong wind from S.W. by the wind S.W. under Top Sails & under at sundown took in sail Middle part Moderate latter part set Top Sails and covered by the wind S.W. by S. Long Lat 30° 25'

Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 1843

Commenced strong wind at sundown took in sail to the S.W. Middle overcast latter under Top Sails to the S.W. by S. Long 166° 07' East Lat 30° 58'

Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July

Commenced with fresh wind from S.E. under Top Sails & covered to the S.W. by S. at sundown took in sail Middle part latter part set sail out several ships in sight Long 166° 19' East Lat 30° 25'

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July

First part of this day fine all sail at spots the Harvest of Anticosti 32 months old 1350<sup>th</sup> Middle part under short sail latter all sail out to the East wind S.E. several ships in sight all carrying sail to the East for Plenty of ships and no whales Lat 30° 25'

Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July

Commenced fine all sail out to the East several ships in sight doing nothing at sundown took in sail Middle part fine latter part same all sail out to the East Long 168° 35' East Lat 30° 16'

Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> July

Commenced fine all sail out to the S.W. by S. wind South at sundown took in sail Middle part fine latter same all sail out to the East Long Lat 30° 05'

Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail out to the East wind S.E. at 4 o'clock tacked ship to the S.W. took in light sails at sundown Middle part latter part same all sail out to the S.W. by S. wind S.E. 2 sail in sight Lat 29° 43'
