Saturday 6th July 1843

First part of this day all sail out to the S W by S wind S E at sundown took in light sails latter fine all sail out by the wind South

Lat 29° 04'

Sunday 7th July

Commenced fine all sail out to the South 2 sail in sight at 4 P M spoke ship Salom of Warren 7 months out clean left Boston and Addison left West had got nothing since spoke last. Middle fine latter same by the wind to the S E all sail set

Lat 29° 18'

Monday 10th July

First part of this day fine all sail out day after day nothing in sight but ships and they doing the same as us Middle and latter parts calm variable the wind off

Tuesday 11th

Ann Sanford First part of this day calm 1 ship in sight Middle part same latter part 2 ships in sight light wind from S E

Wednesday 12th

Commenced fine light air from the North at sundown took in light sails heading to the East Middle fine latter light air from S E all sail out

Long 169° 02' East

Lat 29° 45'

Thursday 13th

Commenced fine all sail out to the S E spoke Bk Gunther 25 months out 660 P M and a session in company the B had spoke Bk Fortune of Plymouth from the west 4.50 P M spoke Bk Albany Middle part fine latter part saw several sail passed within 1/2 mile of the Port and saw a ship cutting the windward

Friday 14th July

First part of this day wind S E by E the wind to the S saw 2 ships supposed in chase of whales. Middle part fine by the wind to the S E latter to the North all sail out

Lat 30° 20'

Saturday 15th July

Commenced fine all sail set to the S wind S by E saw 1 ship whaling Middle part fine at daylight all sail to the S E fine weather

Long 169° 20' East

Lat 30° 45'

Sunday 16th July

Commenced fine all sail out wind S E passed a carcass saw 2 ships at sundown took in light sails Middle fine latter packed Ship to the S E all sail out

Lat 30° 55'

Macle Pigs

Monday 17th

First part of this day wind S by E all sail out at sundown took in light sails latter all sail out to the S E Macle Pigs

Long 170° 05' East

Lat 31° 00'

Tuesday 18th

Commenced fine all sail out wind S at sundown packed Ship to the North took in light sails latter all sail out wind S E by E 1 ship in sight

Lat 30° 17'

Wednesday 19th

Commenced fine light wind from S E all sail out at Middle part fine latter fresh wind 1 sail in sight

Lat 31° 05'

Thursday 20th July

First part of this day strong breeze took in 3 sails wind S E by the wind S E at sundown took in 3 sails latter fine Macle all sail to the North

Long 170° 30' East
