Friday 21st July

First part of this day as usual saw
Dutchers wind E & E at sundown took in sail Middle and later
strong winds under single Reefs to the E by E wind E & E E
Lat 31° 57

Saturday 22nd July

Commenced fine with strong wind
under single Reefs and courses to the S & E at sundown took in sail
later as the first part saw 2 ships standing to the E
Lat 30° 42

Sunday 23rd

First part of these 24 hours
strong winds from E & E laying S & E at sundown took in sail
Middle and later Main Moderate 2 sail in sight
Long 170° 36 East Lat 29° 44

Monday 24th

Commenced with fair weather
by the wind to the S & E at sundown Doubled Reefs later made
all sail under E & E
Lat 30° 42

Tuesday 25th

Commenced as usual all sail out
sail in sight under E & E 2 ships ahead at sundown sail later
first wind E & E laying E & E 2 sail in sight
Lat 29° 23

Wednesday 26th

First part of this day fine plenty
fair backs wind E by E at 5 took a ship to the East took
in light sails Middle and later fine all sail out to the E & W
Lat 29° 20

Thursday 27th

Commenced as usual made New
Spencer but of Main staysails Middle as usual later same
all sail out to the North 2 sail in sight
Long 170° 15 East Lat 29° 40

On Tabor

Friday 25th July

First and Middle parts same as usual
Painted Main Mast Middle calm later calm saw a ship
Hoisting Lat 30° 17

Saturday 26th July

First part of this day calm
ship in sight Hoisting at sundown light breeze from East
Middle light air later all sail out to the E & E
Lat 30° 35

Sunday 30th

First part of this day fine wind
East of the wind over E all sail out Middle part breeze up
later parts by the wind to the S & E under Double Reefs
Equally Long 170° 06 East Lat 30° 35

Monday 31st

Commenced equally strong wind
from E & E S & E under Double Reefs at sundown Josed Reefs
Main 1/2 sail, took in all sail fresh squalls and rain later parts
squalls of rain other ways fine under top sails & course
Lat 30° 14



Tuesday 1st August 1843

Commenced with fine breeze from
W by S by the wind to the west 1 ship in sight to the East at
sundown took a ship to the East under Double Reefs later all
sail out about star Mission top 3 sail
Long 169° 45 East Lat 30° 20

Wednesday 2nd August

First part of these 24 hours
fine pleasant weather all sail out at sundown took in sail
Middle and later parts fine weather all sail out
to the E by at wind S & E by S & W saw 2 ships joining
Long 170° 43 East Lat 30° 35
