

Ship Clifton Wayne

Sunday August 27th

Commences with light airs from S.W. Middle and latter parts same all sail out & at 8 sail in sight. Lat 29° 27'

Monday August 28th

First part of these 24 hours fair course E. wind S.W. & sail in sight - look in S. P. sails latter all sail set with light airs Lat 29° 45'

Tuesday August 29th

First part of these 24 hours fair all sail light airs from S.E. and South by the wind to the East spoke Ship Harvest 36 months out 1400 and Levi Starbuck 27 months 1700 the Middle and latter parts fair Lat 30° 00'

Wednesday August 30th

First part of these 24 hours rainy and squally however for Blackfish without success Middle and latter parts fair

Thursday 31st August

First part of this day rainy Middle and latter parts same plenty of rain under short sail

Friday September 1st 1843

Commences overcast and raining wind all around the compass Middle and latter parts fair

Long 178° 16' East Lat 29° 45'

Saturday Sept 2^d

First part of these 24 hours fair all sail out at 8 Middle and latter fair Lat 30° 00'

Sunday 3^d Sept

Commences fair all sail out to the S.E. Middle and latter parts fair wind E. S.E. 3 ships in sight Lat 30° 29'

On Japan

Monday 4th Sept

Commences fair all sail set in S.E. starboard tack aboard Middle Cabin latter same however the Liverpool Packet of St. Bedford Capt. Place 21 months out 500 tons 1000 Whales Boiling a large whale Lat 30° 44'

Tuesday 5th Sept

First part of these 24 hours calm the W. & L. P. in company Middle and latter parts calm Lat 30° 15'

Wednesday 6th

First part calm Middle Cabin latter calm however for Fishbacks without success Lat 29° 55'

Thursday 7th Sept

First part calm fair breeze (my jaggery) Middle light wind at daylight fair breeze from S.E. by the wind at 8 & 3 ships in sight 1 Bk Long 178° 57' East Lat 30° 25'

Friday 8th Sept

First part of these 24 hours squalls of rain from S.E. by the wind East at 4 spoke Ship Japan 24 months out 1150 tons Susan 22 mo. 500 tons and Oryza 1300 tons all of which Middle fair looking to the West latter parts strong breeze saw 4 sail Lat 30° 10'

HOPS 1000. SANFORD Saturday 9th Sept

Commences fair saw Fishbacks & much track of ship to the S.E. at sundown at sundown took in light sails latter light wind from the South Lat 30° 04'

Sunday 10th Sept

First part of these 24 hours showery wind for all quarters 1 sail in sight Middle & latter parts light airs from S.E. and thereabouts 3 sail in sight Long about 179° 15' East Lat 30° 25'
