

Ship Clifford Wagon
Monday September 11th 1843

First part of these 24 hours very light air from various points of the compass & sail in sight. Middle & latter parts Calm. Lat 30° 20'

Tuesday 12th

First part Calm Middle and latter parts same. Lat 30° 35'

Wednesday 13th

First part Calm repairing sails and other jobs about the ship. Middle and latter parts light air blowing S.W.

Thursday 14th Sept

First part of this day Calm to work at blacksmithing. Middle parts light breeze from S & E latter parts all sail out to the South

Long 179° 45' East Lat 30° 00' N

Friday 15th Sept

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail out to the S & E wind East at sundown took in light sails latter parts heading S & E repaired fore sail

Long 180° 00' Lat 29° 30'

Saturday 16th Sept

First part of these 24 hours fine wind E by S backed ship to the S & E all sail out at sundown took in top & lower latter all sail out by North Day Lat 30° 00' North

Sunday 17th Sept

First part of these 24 hours good breeze from E by S all sail out by the wind & backed ship to the S & E took in top & lower latter all sail out by North Day Lat 30° 00' North

Long 179° 00' West Lat 31° 05'

Shoals Sandwich Islands

Monday September 18th 1843

First part of these 24 hours fine weather wind S & E sail set by the wind & backed Middle no alteration latter Calm Lat 30° 15'

Tuesday September 19th

First part of these 24 hours Calm employed different jobs Middle and latter parts fine breeze from S & E Lat 30° 40'

Wednesday 20th September

Commenced fine back ship to the East wind S & E Middle and latter parts fine weather Course East Lat 30° 42'

Thursday 21st Sept

First part of these 24 hours fine weather all sail set Course East wind S by E Middle parts took in top & lower latter all sail out light air

Long 179° 00' West Lat 30° 35'

Friday 22nd Sept

First part of these 24 hours Calm making span yarn Middle entirely Calm latter parts very small breeze from S & W saw a sail bound East Lat 30° 20'

Saturday 23rd Sept

First part of these 24 hours fine and almost Calm Middle parts breeze up from S & W latter all sail out with a strong breeze Long 178° 50' West Lat 29° 55'

Sunday 24th Sept

Commenced with a strong breeze from S & W Course E by S at sundown took in top & lower Middle equally at daylight Doubled up top & lower sails at 4th O'clock raised foremast to windward going to windward made sail and beat up for then without success strong wind and ruggel did nothing give it up at noon

Long 173° 25' West Lat 29° 45' North
