

Ship Clifford Wayne of Fairhaven.

Monday September 25th

Commenced with strong breeze from the S E. Under single Reef saw the whales the last time at 1 O'clock. The windward halying by the wind to the E S E. Middle very heavy squalls with plenty of rain. Latter cleared off wind changed to the S W.

Lat 29° 36'

Tuesday Sept 26th

First part of these 24 hours almost calm with a heavy swell from the W. S W. Course & all sail out. Middle and latter parts little or no wind. Long by Alt 175° 00' Lat 29° 20'

Wednesday Sept 27th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather with E S E and light by the wind to the S E. Turned up the Mizzen Mast rigging and with various other small jobs. Middle and latter parts light air from the S E & halying North. Lat 29° 39'

Thursday Sept 28th

Commenced with fine weather as usual. Wind S E on the wind. S W sat up. Kind turned up the Main Mast rigging. Middle and latter parts working to the Eastward. Fine saw bottles but did not ascertain what they were.

Lat 29° 55'

Friday Sept 29th

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail sat by the wind to the S E. Employed about the rigging. Middle and latter parts light air from the East on the latter took by the wind. Long 171° 50' West Lat 30° 25'

Saturday Sept 30th

First part of this day light air to work on the rigging. Middle and latter parts calm and very light air. Saw nothing more remarkable.

Lat 30° 40'

The Sandwich Islands

Sunday October 1st 1843

Commenced with light air and calm from the S E. Middle parts squally with a fresh breeze latter parts strong winds from S E and S E on the wind S E.

Long 170° 30' West

Lat 31° 10'

Monday Oct 2nd

Commenced with strong winds from S E. In fore & Mizzen for Sails. Middle & latter strong breezes by the wind. Fine seeing H. B. S.

Lat 31° 55'

Tuesday Oct 3rd

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from S E by the wind S. Tacks Middle and latter parts more moderate all sail sat. Long 167° 40' West Lat 32° 10'

Wednesday Oct 4th

First part of this day fine. Course & wind North Middle and latter parts fine breezes from S W. Course & all sail sat employed at mending down down rigging.

Long 166° 00' West

Lat 31° 55'

Thursday Oct 5th

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail out. Wind S W. Course East Middle parts same latter part in the S E. Sail employed mending down. Long 162° 55' W Lat 31° 30'

Friday Oct 6th

First part of these 24 hours strong wind from S E W. Course & at sundown Double. Middle parts no alteration in wind in weather. Lat 30° 55'

Saturday Oct 7th

First part of these 24 hours as the last employed at scraping the wheel. Middle Course S E & latter more moderate sat the top Sails wind S by W.

Long 159° 00'

Lat 30° 12'
