Tuesday 31st 1843

First part of these 24 hours Calm
got the steering sail boom up Middle parts light air from the E & E latter
parts light wind by the wind to the N E & W in air E by the wind

Wednesday 1st November

Commenced fine light wind from E & E
Bent New Main sail by the wind S by the wind Middle & latter parts fine
course all sail out heading N by E

Lat 25° 00

Thursday 2nd November

First part of these 24 hours as usual
no alteration in wind or weather 2 sail in sight steering by the wind to
the South, appeared 2 spankers 2 ships in sight on the wind 2 ships
Middle & latter parts strong breeze all sail out

Friday 3rd Nov

First part of these 24 hours strong
breeze from E & E took in S & W Mizen Cap & Sails by the wind Middle
and latter parts single reefed the Top Sails 1 ship coming up with
us

Boat off Cape St. Lucas & Maria Island
Saturday 4th November 1843

Commenced rigged with fresh gales from
E & E by the wind 2 ships Middle parts doubled reefed the Top Sails
1 ship and 2 spankers 1 ship in sight

Sunday 5th November

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from
E & E by the wind single reefed the E & E Middle and latter parts
made all sail wind E & E

Monday 6th November

Commenced fine all sail set at 7 o'clock wind
set the Harvest in sight Middle and latter parts wind S & E laying E & E
all light winds

Long 157° 07

Lat 31° 31 N

Tuesday 7th November

Commenced fine weather all sail set to the
E & E Middle and latter parts fine breeze from the South course E & E
Fore Top & Steering Sail and Main S. P. S. Sail set

Lat 31° 58

Wednesday 8th Nov

Commenced fine fresh breeze from S & E
all sail set course E & E Middle parts strong gale latter parts
made all sail

Lat 32° 20

Thursday 9th Nov

First part of these 24 hours overcast and
breeze wind S. Course E & E the Harvest in sight Middle and latter
parts fine wind from South to S W and fine weather

Long 157° 15 West Lat 32° 28

Friday 10th Nov

Commenced with weather and light wind from
the South course E & E all sail set Middle parts wind shaker to the S & E
took in the steering sail latter parts fine breeze and fine weather
course E & E Long about 157° 00 West
